

Arlington Softball Board 2021

- Arlington Softball Stats
 - 70 Girls signed up this year
 - Last year prior to Covid we had 78 Girls signed up. I am happy with the stable number
 - We general open registration around mid January, and Close February 1st.
 - We had 5 teams this year
 - 8U,10U,12U,14U,16/18U
 - This was the first year we were able to have an 8U team
 - We participate in the Logan Valley League and have for quite some time
 - The league is currently split into 2 divisions, North and South.
 - Most of our games are played:
 - North and South Between North Bend and Yutan
 - East and West between North Bend to Bennington.
- Mothers Day Tournament
 - May 7,8,9
 - 3 age Groups 10U, 12U, 14U
 - 8 Teams per age group for a total of 24 teams.
 - There was a total of 57 games played over that 3 day weekend.
 - Utilizing 3 of the 4 fields at the complex,
 - And also the Bell Creek Field
 - The Mothers Day Tournament is typically our main fund raising event for Arlo Softball
 - \$6800 in Team Registration
 - \$5,000 to \$6,000 in Gate Admissions
 - Around Another \$2,000 in Money Collected by the Concessions stand.
 - Expenses
 - Umpires are our biggest expense typically around \$5200
 - The Money Collected from the tournament
 - Help with offsetting some of the cost we have to Run AYS Softball such as:
 - League tournament fees
 - District Tournament Fees
 - State Tournament Fees
 - Of course Equipment Upgrades
 - We invited Roots to Wings this year to
 - Set up a table and sell Mothers Day flowers at the tournament.
 - They also sold raffle tickets for the ATV that they were giving away
 - This was a connection to a great organization that I wanted to make last year.
 - Although it does not bring any money into our organization, It is a good way to begin having more community involvement in the tournament here in Arlington, and support a great cause over all.

- I am always open to hearing ideas from others to help drive opportunities for the rest of the community at our events.
- Equipment
 - We did a complete inventory of all Softball Equipment this year
 - We have begun to replace certain pieces of equipment this year such as:
 - Brand new Tee which are More expensive, but will hold up for many more years, and have replacement parts instead of throwing away the old style.
 - We have purchased portable batting nets for each team this year also.
 - Next year I plan on identifying catchers gear that needs to be replaced, and or helmets.
- New board members this year:
 - Cindy Lingenfelter's term expired last year.
 - Appreciate her Service
 - Mandi Lang was the only person to put her hat in the ring this year.
 - She is being put in charge of Media and Marketing this year.
 - We are looking to have a more interactive social media platform
 - Board openings coming up
 - 2 Openings this year
 - August 22nd through September 4th the board will take submissions to run for the softball board
 - The Voting period will be Start Sept 7th and End Sept 18th
 - Anyone who participated in AYS Softball will receive an email this year about this,
 - Mandi will also be putting this out on Social media.
- Other Tournaments
 - We have a great facility. Everyone talks about it
 - Next year, besides our Mothers Day Tournament, I have already negotiated our complex to get a league 10U tournament.
 - We are already discussing the options around having an Arlington 8U Tournament
 - We are also in discussions for an alumni Tournament to be held in the fall
 - And I would like to continue having at least one tournament with an outside organization like Carly's Adult fast Pitch.
