Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:35 p.m.

Motion to approve January Meeting Minutes: M. Kindseth, first; J. Schultz, second. Motion approved.

Motion to approve February Meeting Agenda: K. Krebs, first; J. Schultz, second. Motion approved.

1. President's Update – Tara Blandin, President

- a. Senior Night
 - i. Seniors and parents will be announced at halftime, photos taken after the game
 - ii. Total of 12 seniors; tables set up with 2 displayed on each table
 - iii. Gifts include: 4 x 6 canvas senior photo, Yeti water bottle, FHS ornament with player #, and a Nothing Bundt Cake
 - iv. Booster Club donated \$100 Gift card to Toni Corrado to format senior programs; \$25 was donated to Linda Feldewerd to buy MN emblems for Yeti bottles
 - v. We will print approximately 50 senior booklets with help of Jim Krebs through Loffler
- b. Tiger Fan Club Meeting
 - i. Tiger Classic Tournament will be held Feb. 12-14, 2021
 - ii. Will be a 7th & 8th Grade Boys and Girls combined tournament
- c. MYAS March Tournament
 - i. Boy's 7th & 8th Grade State Tournament to be held Mar. 13-14, 2021
 - ii. The tournament has been approved by Tiger Fan Club
 - iii. Covid Plan must be given to Athletic Director, Bill Tschida
 - iv. No money exchanged; wristbands will be sold ahead of time
 - v. Could possibly charge each team \$100 to be reimbursed for EMT fees
 - vi. 3 coaches and one parent per player is allowed; with 8 players, total is 11 per team
 - vii. Most schools have capacity set at 150 total; 300 at FHS since we have auxiliary gyms
 - viii. We have 45 total families that should each work a shift; Sat. 8am-9pm, Sun. 9am-7pm
 - ix. Set up Friday night after boy's game vs. Eagan; no chairs will be set up
- d. Board Positions
 - i. Will be voting for new board positions at April meeting; terms start May 2021
 - ii. Would like the new treasurer to shadow Jason
- e. Team Bonding T.C. Day
 - i. Could go to bowling alley and wear masks
 - ii. Could practice with younger youth at schools
 - iii. Date for T,C, Day is yet to be scheduled
 - iv. Feed my Starving Children or Food Drive are other ideas for team bonding
 - v. Date to be scheduled
- f. Custodian/Teacher Appreciation Nights
 - i. Custodian Appreciation scheduled for 2/16; only 7 will be working
 - ii. Will write thank you notes, provide a Subway meal and make posters
 - iii. Teacher's Appreciation scheduled 3/04; players can take gift bags to teachers and videotape exchange. Can post exchange on Facebook and Twitter

 - c. State Tournament dates to be determined
 - d. Post season awards
 - i. Will request funds at a later date
 - e. Spring Banquet
 - i. Will be scheduled in April in the evening in HS Cafeteria
 - ii. Parents of players and managers will be invited; total of 156
 - iii. Need to be catered; could also bring own meals from home
 - iv. JV/ Varsity and 9th / 10th Grades could break up into two groups
 - v. Would like to have someone volunteer as a videographer to put photos to music
3. Treasurer's Report – Jason Schultz, Treasurer
 - a. Budget
 - i. Only \$150 is budgeted for Banquet
 - b. Donations
 - i. \$7140 made through Donation Drive
 - ii. \$1935 made through GoFundMe Campaign
 - iii. Received Booster Club Fees from all families; extra \$140 than expected
 - c. Expenses
 - i. Estimated at \$8000 for Assistant Coaches, photos, shooting shirts, etc.
 - d. Checking Balance
 - i. \$13,680.47 in checking account
 - ii. Currently have \$6730.24 available for next year
 - e. MYAS Tournament
 - i. Expecting that with a total 37- 44, we may require 5-hour long volunteer shifts
 - ii. Costs may include Custodian: \$1400 and EMT: \$600 for a total of \$2000

 - a. Will be putting together gift bags for players for away games
5. Fundraising Update – Julie Mogensen, Fundraising Director
 - a. Group garage sale could be another fundraiser
5. Additional Items /Concerns
