The first tournaments start the first part of May. Check the calendar on the Region website's beach page for the ages and dates of tournaments.

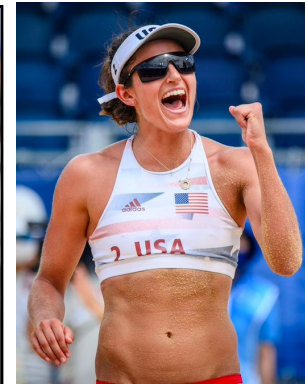
Reminders:

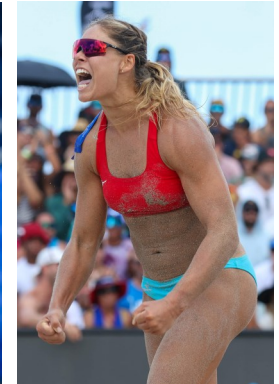

2024 AZ Region Jr. Beach Program Overview

REGISTRATION

Registration for the Jr. Beach program can be completed by mailing this form with payment of \$20 to the AZ Region office OR online through your SportsEngine account.

HOW IT WORKS

Teams are made up of two boys or two girls and are guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches depending on the number of teams in the tournament. If an age division is represented by three or fewer teams, those teams may be asked to play up an age division to ensure more matches. The teams moving up can still earn medals for their appropriate age group.

Teams officiate their own matches. Officiating clinics will be conducted at the beginning of each tournament. If there is a dispute, it will be settled by the Tournament Director, NOT Parent or Coaches.

MATCH FORMAT

The tournament format will depend upon the number of teams and age division and will be determined by the Tournament Director. Variations could include one game rally score to 30, one game rally score to 21, one game rally score to 15 or two out of three games rally score to 15 or 21, third game to 15. All games must be won by two points. Our goal is the most amount of play for our athletes in the time parameters we have per tournament.

PARTNERS

Players do not register for the program as teams. Boys or girls sign up for individual tournaments with a partner. Individuals will be assigned points based on their team's finish.

For the last 23 years, this program has provided self learning and real experience for the beach game. Players learn by failing and adapting. Parents are encouraged to not interfere with the tournaments and their athlete's learning and just sit back and enjoy their fleeting opportunities to watch their son and/or daughter play a sport they love. -e

RULES DIFFERENCES AND OFFICIATING

Tournaments will be officiated using USA Volleyball Beach Rule & Regulations. Officiating clinics will be conducted before the start of each tournament. Parents and coaches are encouraged to attend these clinics. The athletes officiate each other. There will not be AZ Region officials used in this program. Please take time to understand the rules differences.

IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- ◆ Registration will begin at 5 pm (1 hour before the scheduled start time). If you arrive later than 6:00 pm you will only be able to participate if teams are needed to fill pools. Pre tournament meeting for rules and pools begins right after registration ends. If you are going to be late please call the tournament director to be put on the tournament roster.
- ◆ Parents and Coaches are NOT permitted on the playing surface at any time. One warning will be given and if not heeded, the player(s) associated with the parent or coach will be forfeited from the tournament and could face expulsion from the program.
- ◆ All players, parents and coaches will be held to the USA Volleyball Code of Conduct. Violations of those rules will result in the appropriate sanctions. Alcohol consumption will not be permitted around Jr. Players per USA Volleyball Code of Ethics.

COSTS

To register for the Arizona Region Beach program, *players will be required to pay a \$20 per athlete registration fee* which covers; tournament insurance, court rentals, administration and site fees. *Tournament fees are \$10 per player.* Players only pay for the tournaments in which they play.
