

Byron Basketball Association Player Expectations and Playing Time Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the expectations for youth basketball players participating in Byron Basketball Association (BBA) to promote a positive and developmental experience for all participants.

Scope

This policy applies to all basketball coaches, including head coaches, assistant coaches, and volunteer coaches, and all players, within our organization.

Expectations:

1. Attendance and Punctuality:

- Players are expected to attend all scheduled practices, games, and team events unless prevented by illness or unforeseen circumstances.
- Players should arrive on time for practices and games to ensure adequate warm-up and preparation time.

2. Attitude and Sportsmanship:

- Players are expected to always demonstrate good sportsmanship, respecting teammates, coaches, opponents, referees, and spectators.
- Players should maintain a positive attitude, support their teammates, and encourage fair play.

3. Effort and Commitment:

- Players are expected to give their best effort during practices and games, striving to improve their skills and contribute to the team's success.
- Players should demonstrate commitment to their team by actively participating in drills, following instructions from coaches, and completing assigned tasks.

4. Behavior and Conduct:

- Players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the team and the organization.
- Use of profanity, disrespectful behavior, or any form of bullying or harassment will not be tolerated.

Consequences of Non-Compliance: Violation of these expectations may result in consequences determined by the coaching staff and/or league officials, which may include, but are not limited to:

- Verbal warnings and discussions with the player and/or parents/guardians
- Temporary suspension from practices or games
- Permanent removal from the team or league
