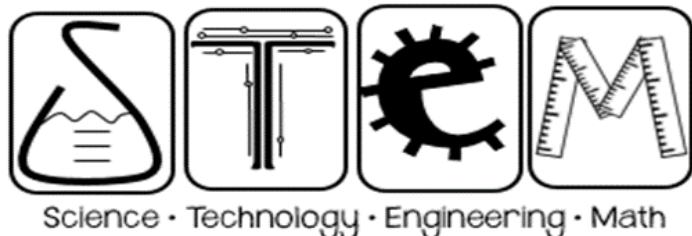

Location: Maize South Middle School, 3403 N. Tyler, Wichita, KS 67205

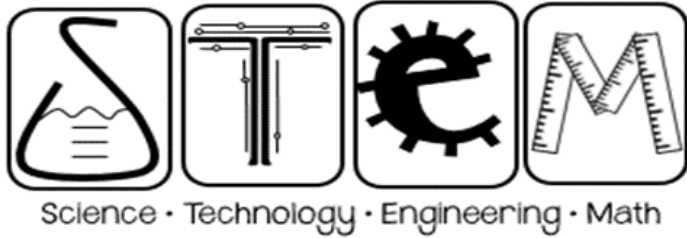
Cost: \$ 180 *Each participant will also get a t-shirt which they will tie dye
