

Coaching Guidelines Grand River Rumble

Outlined below are the expectations for this weekend. If you have any questions, please ask during the coaches meeting. Good luck everyone!

1. We are here for the kids, don't lose sight of this.
2. There will be no more than 2 people in the corner (refer to the procedure for declaring your two coaches in the corner at THE BEGINNING of each dual).
3. Parents need to be in the stands.
4. College out of bounds rules will be used for all matches.
5. If there is a question, 1 (ONE) of the designated two corner coaches may approach the scorer's table for a clarification. No other individual may approach the table during the dual to address the official.
6. If there is a question on a judgment call, it will be enforced as a coach's misconduct.
7. If you, your staff, or wrestler(s) become unsportsmanlike and violate the team bench decorum rule, expect to be hit for unsportsmanlike conduct without warning. This includes but is not limited to: inciting the crowd, inciting the other team's wrestlers, coaches, or fans; yelling across the mat at other coaches; and any other act the referee deems unsportsmanlike.
8. For the GRR, the rules for unsportsmanlike conduct and coaches misconduct will be administered as follows:

Unsportsmanlike conduct by a wrestler (not during the match), coach, or staff will be enforced as follows... first penalty, deduct 1 team point (-1), second penalty, deduct 2 team points (-2) and that person will be taken to the HEAD table for the remainder of the dual. Depending on how many matches are left in the dual, the individual may be required to remain at the head table for part OR all of the following dual.

Coaches misconduct will be enforced as follows... first penalty a warning, second penalty deduct 1 team point (-1), third penalty deduct 2 team points (-2) and the HEAD COACH will be taken to the HEAD table for the remainder of the dual. Depending on how many matches are left in the dual, the individual may be required to remain at the head table for part OR all of the following dual.

Repeated offenses could result in removal from the premises or any other penalty the tournament director and head official deem necessary.

9. Flagrant misconduct will not be allowed or tolerated. If a wrestler or coach commits an act of flagrant misconduct as defined by the NFHS rules, this person will be immediately disqualified from the match in process. NFHS procedure for a flagrant misconduct act shall be enforced. The match official shall immediately advise the nearest pod leader of the situation. The match official, the party in mention, and their coach (if a wrestler) shall immediately go to the head table where the incident will be addressed to the tournament director and head official so a final determination of whether the party will be allowed to continue for the weekend.
10. Should you have an issue with an official in regards to safety, please let the head official know. He will do his best to resolve any issues.
11. There will be video review this weekend in the GOLD BRACKET ONLY during the DUAL TOURNAMENTS Friday and Sunday. There will be no video review in the individual tourney.
12. If there is an issue with an official not in regards to safety, please let the head official know, he will talk with that official.
