

# Guest Player Rules and Registration Instructions

Number of rostered guest players allowed:

U7-U/10—up to 2 guest players not to exceed the maximum roster limits for each age group.

U11-U19—up to 3 guest players not to exceed the maximum roster limits for each age group.

**OSA POLICIES PROHIBIT A COMPETITIVE PLAYER WITH A US SOCCER ORGANIZATION GUEST PLAYING WITH A RECREATIONAL TEAM.**

**IMPORTANT: In order for guest players to be approved for play, compliance with the items below is required:**

## **GUEST PLAYER FORM**

**OSA teams** – The parents of the guest player must fill out & submit the Oklahoma Soccer Association guest player form before a guest player can attend the tournament. This form can be found in your GotSport account under “forms.” (This is ONLY for players currently registered through OSA who will be guest playing with another OSA registered team)

**NOTE:** After you open the OSA Guest Player Form, you will need to click ‘select’ or ‘continue’ next to your child’s name. Then, proceed through the form. You will enter all the tournament and guest player information on the third page. Take a screen shot of that page and print it. When you try to just print it, it doesn’t show up correctly. OSA should also email you a confirmation of registering as a guest player. Send all of this information to the coach you will be guest playing for.

**Non OSA Teams** – If your team is not registered through OSA, please refer to your State Association for guest player requirements.

**OFFICIAL ROSTER:** Coach or Manager must have a copy of the guest player’s “Official Roster” to verify the guest player is age appropriate and currently registered with a sanctioned club at the field at all times. You can obtain an “Official Roster” from the guest player’s club registrar or club president.

**MEDICAL RELEASE:** Coach or Manager must have a medical release for each guest player signed by the parent/guardian at the field at all times. The USYS medical release form can be found on the OSA website <https://www.oksoccer.com/forms-and-documents/>.

**PLAYER PASS:** Coach or Manager must have a copy of the guest player’s Player Pass for Check-in and have a laminated color pass at the field for all games. (Only if the league in which they play requires Player Passes)

**NOTE:** This process may take several days and must be completed in time to have your paperwork by tournament time. (Do not wait until the week of the tournament to direct register a player, it may be too late.) Proof of direct registration and player pass (U9-U19) are required and must be included in the teams tournament documents. Needed documents can be found here:

**OSA DIRECT REGISTRATION:** If a guest player of an OSA registered team is not rostered with a club the Parent/Guardian will need to direct register the Player with Oklahoma Soccer Association as a tournament player. The team manager or coach will need to have a copy of the documents received once registration is complete with them at the field at all times.

**DIRECT REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:** Use the following steps to register a player that is not currently registered with any USYS club for the 2024-2025 season. This registration is not for use in regular-season games. This is for tournament-only guest players and the player pass will indicate such.

1. Go to the OSA Website: <https://www.oksoccer.com/forms-and-documents/>.
2. Click on “Direct/Tournament Player Registration” (Do not create a new player profile. Please use the existing player account in GotSport)
3. Once you have completed the registration on GotSport, email a copy of the player’s birth certificate or government id to [pauletta@oksoccer.com](mailto:pauletta@oksoccer.com).
4. After verification, an approved registration form and player pass will be sent to you. Registrations are not complete until you receive the approved forms and player pass.

Please allow a minimum of 48 hours for your request to be processed. The player’s registration is not complete until you receive the approved registration form back from the OSA office.
