**Taylor High School Athletic Booster Club Board  
General Meeting Minutes from November 3, 2025**

President Brad Ingram called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. from the LGI.

Secretary Shelley Eastland was present and requested a committee to review minutes for this meeting: Tara Weatherwax, Susie Boyce and Helena Townsend. Thank you to Monica Ingram, Michael Seago and Jenny Swaney for reviewing last month's minutes which were approved and posted to the online archive.

President Brad Ingram- reported on behalf of other AOR below.

Treasurer/Financial Report Brad for Michael Seago – See financials online as reports were not ready in time for tonight's meeting.

VP-Fundraising Brad for Kim Koehn – Kendra Scott give-back event Nov. 29 Sat after Thanksgiving for the for in-person (likely 4-6:00 pm) and online shopping for 3-days after Thanksgiving. Last year we made around \$1200 so it's usually worthwhile to do it.

VP-Programs Helena Townsend – We sold about 35 programs for the band edition with pre-sales. Helena is thinking about doing pre-sales for all of them next year. She is considering publishing a super senior edition; we will print other sports but need coaches to request and provide team photos; they would be available for distribution at end-of-season banquet.

VP-Concessions Taryn/Susan – Taryn moved to upgrade the Clover system as follows: to approve the funds to replace three clover minis with one mini and two stations at an approximate cost of \$8K and to move from a purchase agreement to a leasing agreement with Clover. It was seconded by Becca and carried with no opposition. This upgrade will add a Clover Station to both the FB and Indoor stands as well as two Flexes and one bar scanner. The current Flexes will continue to be used and likely will need to be replaced in another year or two. A new account will be opened for the Softball stand as well. The leasing option allows for the equipment to be upgraded regularly and provides a better warranty in the event of issues.

VP-Membership/Technology Tara Weatherwax – nothing new on website; coaches have pages and they really need to be updated; contact Tara for assistance; Brooke has written instructions to share with coaches by request; need to add bowling to the dropdown sports menu on the website; Tara to follow up with Kristen Samuelson about updating the school website link with our new domain address. Membership: up to 103 members, but only 3 coaches so far.



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VP-Volunteers Becca Wolfgang – student no-shows has been a problem in the stands this year; NHS staff sponsor, Mrs. Johnson, suggested a video be shared with students (NHS is too large to host in-person student meetings); Brad and Becca plan to schedule a meeting with Mrs. Johnson to explore other solutions;

VP- Spirit Wear Sara Brown – reported we are almost out of beanies so she's trying to restock a comparable product for reasonable price and also is looking into scarves and blankets; online sale planned before winter break; Jenny did an amazing job with pink out shirts and we thank her for a job well done;

Coach Reports –

Football- Chris Babin is 10 months into his new role; it's been an adjustment to say the least but very pleased with sub-varsity FB and the foundation being laid; benefits starting to be seen; from an all-sports fundraising standpoint last year totaled \$90,000 raised for the year and as of end of Oct. this year \$102,000.00 has already been raised. He is developing a Facility Portfolio across the campus and seeking long-term donors/partners by building relationships. New uniforms typically cycle every 3-4 years, but KISD school board put a freeze on purchasing new uniforms, but there is an alternative uniform loophole that allows booster club funds to be used. His goal is to make sure the sports in desperate need of uniforms get what they need. Getting new back lighted running Ts for rotunda and competition gym; upgrades to swim, soccer, golf hallway and locker rooms; add graphic art to locker rooms for girls JV volleyball and basketball to enhance it;

Volleyball - Brooke Plemons reported the season finished a week and a half ago. Varsity finished 5<sup>th</sup> for 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row; in-coming freshman look promising; the end of season banquet is scheduled for Dec. 4 at Legacy; doing end of season meetings now and will move into off-season soon.



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
