Director of Coaching Report

1. Fall Competitive Teams

- a. For the most part doing well. Some divisional issues in Indy and made for some teams to be unsuccessful. White teams have picked up some nice wins in tournaments and getting some hardware with our blue teams.
- b. League: Some growing pains, especially on the older girl’s side. I think a lot is due to Eclipse & some of the clubs not strong in depth. Talk to a few people about it and recommending SLYSA and CIA. Setting a date for a technical committee meeting.
- c. Training-On the surface going well. Some time issues with some coaches with busy schedules. Made a point to check in on every team the past month to see how they are doing and if they need anything from me. Continue to check in on the younger coaches.
