2024 WCLA FAQ

- Q: Where do I find the WCLA Team Application? When is it due?
- A: Register for the USAL WCLA; Due December 1 annually to avoid late fees; must be received by March 1 or prior to first game to be eligible for Nationals.
- Q: What are the WCLA Team Dues? What is the deadline to pay WCLA dues?
- A: WCLA Dues are \$450 Full Member & \$250 Provisional Member. They are due December 1 annually to avoid late fees; must be received by March 1 or prior to first game to be eligible for Nationals (Full Members; Provisional Members are not eligible for Nationals).
- Q: How do we pay our WCLA Dues?
- A: 1. Most leagues will collect WCLA dues with their league dues and submit a single payment to USAL for all their member teams.
 - 2. For new leagues, teams can pay their WCLA dues directly to USAL by check (payable to USA Lacrosse, 2 Lovton Circle, Sparks, MD 21152) or by credit card. To pay by credit card teams need to request a secure link through Liz Piper, epiper@usalacrosse.com.
- Q: What if my school requires an invoice before we can pay our dues?
- A: Please email Liz Piper, epiper@usalacrosse.com.
- Q: Is USA Lacrosse Membership Mandatory?
- A: Yes, all players and coaches must be USA Lacrosse Members through April 30 annually. Nationals teams must have current membership through May 31.
- Q: What is the USAL Membership join/renew deadline?
- A: February 15 or prior to your first game whichever is earliest.
- Q: I'm 18 years old and can only register as a high school player. Do I need to do anything to my membership?
- A: No, the membership is based on age and will cover you even if you turn 19 years old during the year.
- Q: What is the join/renew process for USA Lacrosse?
- A: You can find the link to join/renew here, Join WCLA and USA Lacrosse.
- Q: Can we register our entire team for USA Lacrosse Membership?
- A: Please contact USAL for details, WCLA@usalacrosse.com.
- Q: How do we validate our USAL Memberships?
- A: NEW: This season players and coaches will be required to register on the WCLA website to validate their USAL memberships. Only active memberships through April 30 or later will be allowed to register.
- Q: What is the difference between the Membership Validation and Roster Verification?
- A: The membership validation confirms USA Lacrosse membership. The Roster Verification form confirms athletes' fulltime enrollment and eligibility to participate in the WCLA.
- Q: Where do I find the Roster Verification Form? When is it due?
- A: You can find the current Roster Verification Form here, <u>Join WCLA and US Lacrosse</u>. It is due to your League President by February 15th or prior to your first game. Due to USAL by March 1st.
