Budget

- Projected deficit of \$6,000 at the fall meeting current projection of a surplus of \$7,000 at the completion of this season following final ice fee payments
- RYHA spent more than \$71,000 on ice fees this season which is an increase from the \$44,000 spent in the 2017/2018 season which means more time on ice for players
- Cash on hand is slightly down in comparison to 2017/2018; however we are doing better than we had budgeted for
