

At the Arena Items to Remember.

1. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED** for spectators, volunteers, and coaches at all times while in arena.
2. Players **are required** to wear mask while entering and exiting arena. Players can remove mask for on ice activities.
3. Players or coaches with any risk factors or illnesses should not participate in any on-ice activity. Any players, coaches or spectators **exhibiting symptoms** or signs of an illness **should not be in the facility** at any point.
4. All participants must be USA Hockey registered for the 2020-21 season to participate in any Minnesota Hockey sanctioned on-ice activity.
5. Players should arrive at the rink **no more than 15 minutes** before the start of on-ice activities. Anyone arriving **earlier than 15 minutes before** their start time should **wait outside** of the facility and be socially distanced from others.
6. If there is an activity occurring at the rink before the team's scheduled start, the incoming team should wait until all players from the prior event have vacated the building. **There should not be interaction between the two groups.**
7. For practices or clinics,
 - a. Peewee, 12U & Bantam players should be dropped off at the rink, and picked up afterward. **Parents/Guardians should not be in the arena.**
 - b. 6U, 8U, 10U Girls & Squirt players are allowed **1 parent/guardian** in the rink. Parent may stay during practice but must socially distance from others. Parents may bring siblings or younger children along but it is recommended to find alternative options.
8. For Games and Scrimmages
 - a. **2 spectators** per player allowed.
 - b. **Must wear mask** and **social distance** from other families
9. Players, Officials, and Coaches should **arrive fully dressed**. It is advised to have a set of skate guards for putting skates on prior to entering arena. There is a small area for putting skates on. Goalies will have a designated area for dressing in additional gear.
10. Bring bottle and drink from home water fountains are turned **OFF** inside the arena. Bottle must be clearly marked with players name and team.
