Notice of Race

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority (OA) for this regatta is the Cedar Lake Yacht Club (CLYC)

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Inland Lakes Yachting Association, and the prescriptions of the X Class Association.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all X Class boats whose skipper meets invitation criteria as defined in Appendix 1.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an official entry form available online only at www.clyc.com > Regattas > AJX

The entry form is considered part of the NOR even though it is a separate form.

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee is \$45.00

4.2 Entries received after June 12, 2026 will be subject to an additional fee of \$10.00.

4.3 The \$45 entry fee includes skipper and crew lunches, and trophies

4.4 Please purchase additional lunches for non-sailors/coaches in advance. Additional lunches may be available on a limited basis day of the regatta.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 A maximum of five races may be sailed.

Friday, June 19, 2026

7:30 Launching starts

8:00 Motor boats may be launched starting at 8am

9:00 Competitors' briefing at the CLYC flagpole

10:00 1st Warning Signal

- The time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted except when races are sailed back-to-back.
- No warning signal will be made after 4:00pm if three races have been completed.
- Awards ceremony after racing at regatta headquarters.

6. LAUNCHING

The parking lot outside the gate will be used to stage boats getting ready to launch. Sailboat launching will be on the morning of June 19. Please have a coach boat available to help get your sailors moored. It is recommended to have a mooring with twenty feet of line. Motorboats may be launched at the club after 8am.

Cedar Lake Yacht Club practices and supports Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 40. The invasive species rule. Therefore it is expected that all boats, both power and sail will be free of all vegetation before you launch and upon leaving the lake. Furthermore, bilge water must also be absent before launching and upon leaving.

7. CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse will be open throughout the event.

8. BATHROOMS

Club bathrooms will be open.

9. LUNCH

There will be lunches included for registered skippers and crews. There will be a lunch break on shore. Additional lunches will also be available for spectators/coaches for a fee on a limited basis. Advance purchase of meals for coaches and support persons are strongly encouraged.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

RRS Appendix S "Standard Sailing Instructions" shall apply, except as modified by the Supplemental Sailing Instructions (the Supplement). The Supplement will be available before the start of the regatta at www.clyc.com under "Regattas" and "AJX 2026", during registration at the regatta site. This meets the requirements of RRS 25.

11. VENUE

Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Big Cedar Lake, located near Slinger, WI.

12. THE COURSES

The courses will be as specified in RRS Appendix S or as modified in the Supplement.

13. SCORING

13.1 One race is required to constitute a regatta.

13.2 Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.1

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

14.1 The Race Committee will be communicating among themselves and to the fleet before, during, and after racing using channel 72.

14.2 Competitors will be allowed to receive radio communication from the race committee, including notifications at the start of the race. Competitors may not make radio transmissions while on the water except in an emergency or to notify the race committee of withdrawal from the race.
