Proceedings

Meeting called to order by Ben Goodman at 7:33pm. With a quorum of Directors being present, the meeting proceeded with business. At this time, the Board approved discussed, amended and approved the meeting minutes from July 8th, 2019.

Program Updates

The Board received the following updates:

- In-house (M. Goodman)
 - o In-house basketball in-house registration is now open
 - Planning on sending a flier home in Friday folders to all of the feeder schools within the first few weeks of school
 - o In-house registration closes September 30th
- Boys Traveling (Gustafson/Nathan)
 - Here is a quick synopsis of the highlights from MYAS preseason meeting that I attended last week:
 - 1. MYAS tournaments will now be called winter shootouts instead of supersavers. They have focused on improving the quality for players and teams. This is not something we typically have played in, at least with boys teams, but to consider if we needed an extra tournament to play in. \$225 entry fee (175 if before august 30)
 - 2. Several new partnerships with MYAS this year:
 - Youth 1st: Organization dedicated to good sportsmanship, changing culture around youth sports. They provide awards to teams for conduct during the season (players, coaches, parents all contribute). They will do presentations to organizations (if we wanted to do so) Trusted officials: New program to help refs move from in-house to travel. They host live clinics and will soon have on-line clinics (also an opportunity for us)
 - Trusted Coaches Program: Organization that does all background checks, first aid training, concussion certificates, etc. for coaches so that everything is in one place. They all host clinics for basketball coaches on practices, skills, development. 4 September clinics in Blaine. Will also have on-line instruction available. \$20-40/coach enrolled depending on package. trustedcoaches.org for anyone who wants to check it out.
 - 3. Rule Changes for this year:
 - Grades 3-4: person to person defense only (help ok). No full court defense. 12 foot free throws. Ball size 27.5 (both boys and girls)

- Grades 5: person to person defense only (help ok). Person to person full court defense only. 15 foot free throws. Ball size 28.5 (both boys and girls)
- Grades 6: no defensive restrictions half court or full. 15 foot free throws. Ball size 28.5 (both boys and girls)
- Grades 7-12: no defensive restrictions half court or full. 15 foot free throws. Ball size 28.5 (girls) and 29.5 (boys)
- Organizations expected to comply with above rules for tournaments that they host.
- 4. All scores for teams should now be entered in the YBB hoops Hub. It will generate a rankings for teams to improve seedings for state tournament at the end.
- 5. MYAS will provide scheduling services and brackets for tournament directors. Costs \$5 per team in tournament.
- Focusing on FY2020 Goal = 150 players

• Boys Tournament (Rosonke)

- Have confirmed/registered 101 teams for participation-almost all have paid
- o Continued conversations with Ross and Brady for this and next years tournament
- Confirming facilities
- Working on locking down officials and tournament schedule
- Focusing on FY2020 Goal = 150 teams

• Girls Traveling (Ehrman)

- o Girls Traveling nothing new to report
- Focusing on FY2020 Goal = 80 players

• Girls Tournament (Bronson)

- o Have 31 committed teams for participation-but have only received one check so far
- o Waiting on answers on reciprocity from OMGBA, Chaska, Woodbury and Lakeville North
- Have a lot of interest and teams saying they're in but many are waiting until after tryouts to be set on the number of teams to register
- Still pinging new teams from outstate and out-of-state. Was able to get one team from Eau Claire (7th Grade Girls)
- Focusing on FY2020 Goal = 150 teams

- Discussed fundraising using Heggies pizzas; Giving the process a trial run. We will hand out order forms at tryouts, and extra if needed at the parent meeting in September. The deadline for order forms to be turned in will be October 4th, and the pizzas will be picked up at picture night October 29th.
- Discuss potential of e-bids vs. paper sheets (opens up items to those who cannot attend, up to two wks prior to event - ideally generating more money)
- o Concessions: met with Jodee on 7/1 to get up to speed on last two years of coordinating
- Discussed trying to get sponsors, and we will promote with corporate logos. Would also like to get them to sponsor the picture banner for the Champions.
