



## **Parent Expectations**

### PRACTICES:

- Parents will help make sure their child is at every practice on time and prepared to play.
- Parents will encourage their child to work hard, try new things, and be a great teammate each and every practice.

### PLAYING TIME:

- Parents will help their child find meaning in whatever their roles are on the team.
- Parents will respect the coaches' decision on playing time.
  - If there is any conflict during the season, it is the player's obligation to talk to the coach before the parent(s).
- If a player or parent would like to meet or discuss anything with the coach, he/she should wait at least 24 hours after a tournament before contacting the coach. A meeting will then be set up with the parent, player, coach, and directors.

- Parents will demonstrate and model positive support for all players, coaches, and officials.
- Parents will place physical and emotional well being of their child over any personal desire to win.
- Parents will provide support for all coaches and officials working with their child to provide all with a positive experience.
- Parents will not put down or disrespect any other players and coaches of the team.
- Parents will encourage their child and focus on improvements and good sportsmanship over playing time and wins/losses.
