    - Who: Anyone who has responsibilities to work with kids:

    - <u>Background checks</u>: \$30 everyone listed above (reimbursed for Coaches and Officials)
    - How often updated:
      - Safeport: Every year (1st year is 90 min / refresher is 15 min)
      - Background check every other year is now a NATIONAL background check
