2024-2025 ANNUAL REPORT

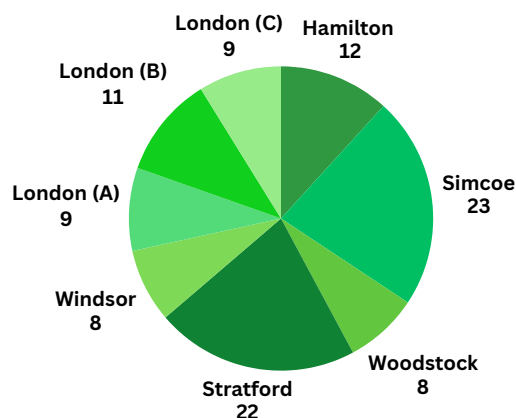
