- Silver, Gold, Diamond, Platinum and Sapphire Xcel divisions must qualify or petition in the AA or as an IES.
- Modified Non-Traditional 2 sets of equipment (one floor) A & B, (judges move back and forth).
- Timed warm up followed by competition on Side A.
- Side B begins to warm up when Side A begins competition.
- No 30-second touch warmup.
- Order of competition is a random draw by athlete & team.
- 2-judge panels.
- No State Team, Super Team or Club Team competition are held.

Qualification Procedures

- Athletes must qualify at their State Championship Competition by achieving the qualifying score:
 - o Silver: 35.50 All-Around
 - o Gold: 34.00 All-Around
 - o Platinum: 33.50 All-Around
 - Diamond: 33.50 All-Around
 - o Sapphire 33.50 All-Around
 - Individual Event Specialist Score: 9.0 per event, maximum 3 events.
- An athlete who can not compete in her State Championship Competition due to <u>illness</u> <u>or injury</u> can petition to enter the Regional Competition by following the procedures outlined in USA Gymnastics Rules & Policies.

Entry Procedures

• Register all professional members and athletes through the USA Gymnastics Meet Reservation System – Registration is currently open.

USAG Sanction

- All payments for Regionals will be done electronically with Meet Maker
 COST IS \$110 per athlete for each division
- Register ALL athletes who may qualify to Regionals and plan to attend before February 1st. This will allow the start of the planning process for Regionals.
- At State Meet, scratch athletes that have not qualified after each session. DO NOT PAY FOR THE ATHLETES UNTIL THE SUNDAY OF STATE MEET AND PAY FOR THEM ALL AT ONCE.
- Register all coaches that may attend Regionals. All coaches must be on the reservation. Failure to register by Wednesday before Regionals will result in a \$100 per coach onsite penalty.
- Registrations not paid for by 11:59pm on the Monday after State Meet will be charged a \$25 per athlete late fee.

Refund Policy

• Refunds due to illness or injury will be awarded up to two (2) weeks prior to the start of the Regional Meet with appropriate physician note. Scratches should be done on Meet Maker & USAG Meet Reservation and a refund request should be emailed to the following:

Xcel Petitions

- Register petitioning athletes on the USA Gymnastics Reservations System when entering your athletes. Pay for your petitioning athletes at the State Meet with the rest of the qualifying athletes. If a petition is not approved the entry fee will be refunded via check.
- Athletes not competing in State Meet should email all required petition documentation prior to State Meet. If injured at the State Meet, coaches must email an intent to petition by the Monday following State Meet. All required petition documentation must be completed and emailed by the Wednesday following State Meet. Email:

Petition Rules

• Gymnasts unable to compete at the State Championships or unable to compete in the All-Around (AA) at State Championships, due to injury or illness can be petitioned to Regionals. This includes AA athletes who are unable to compete on all four (4) events at State Meet, and IES that cannot compete on their selected event(s). Please note, petitions cannot be done if the athlete has competed on all four (4) events at the State Meet.

• The athlete can directly enter the Regional Championships if the following requirements are met, and documentation is included with the petition form:

1. Score Qualifications a. All Around (AA) Petitions for Xcel Silver-Sapphire

i. A photocopy/screenshot of at least one pre-State sanctioned meet results from the current season (at the level to which they are petitioning) showing a score at least one point (1.00) greater than the Regional qualifying score (see Qualification Score section).

iii. Xcel Divisons cannot petition to Regionals as an IES.

2. Medical Qualifications a. A Licensed Medical Professional's written verification of the illness or injury with date of release for returning to athletic activity.

3. Written request from the coach via email.

4. Completed USAG Petition Form

Age Divisions

• Evenly split age groups within each Division with approximately 20 athletes in an age group, maximum of 24 athletes per group.

• Once age groups have been determined from State Meet, a random draw is done by the XRCC, and the Meet Director.

- Session age groupings will be based on the number of athletes.
- Session order will be randomized by XRCC.
- Event rotations will be randomized by Proscore.

• Athletes will be randomized by Proscore. Athletes will then be grouped together with their club in order of randomization.

• IES in a rotation must start on one (1) of their IES events and will be manually moved (if needed).

- Xcel Regional Championships award 40% of participants.
- No Team Awards
- No Participation medals or awards.

- No complimentary coach's food will be provided at Regional Championships.
