PLAYER EVALUATIONS:

- 10U/12U: Player evaluations are mandatory for all players, unless the player is trying out for OHS softball (those players will be evaluated by the OHS coaches' staff during high school tryouts.)
- 14U: Player evaluations were conducted in the fall of 2023 and are considered complete for the 2024 season.

Location: Manthey Fields

Date: Sunday, April 7th

TIME: 10U - 12pm to 1:30pm (all players), 1:30-2:15pm (pitchers and catchers), 12U: 2pm-3:30pm (all players), 3:30-4:15 (pitchers and catchers)

*Mandatory(10U,12U) parent meeting will be held during evaluations 1:30-2pm at Manthey Shelter House

Rain Date: Sunday, April 14th (only if needed,)

** Parent meeting optional for ages 14U and above*

PRACTICES, GAMES, TOURNAMENTS:

- Teams will be posted in shortly after evaluations
- Practices will begin when fields/gyms become available starting in late April/early May (depending on league start date).
- Coaches will notify players of their first practice.
- Tournament dates will be posted on the HFC website as they are confirmed.

WORK DEPOSIT:

- Each family of a registered player is expected to work 6 hours throughout the season (work opportunities may extend into August) to earn back the work deposit fee.
- A maximum of 12 hours per family if multiple players in the program.
- Work opportunities will be communicated via the HFC website and sign up will take place through the DIBS tab on the website. Family members must be a member of the HFC website to sign up for DIBS.
- Opportunities may include meat raffles, pancake breakfast, OHS concessions, home tournament, OHS kid's night, SCFF parking, etc.
- HFC board members or head coaches are exempt from the 6-hour requirement.
- Assistant coaches and Parent Reps get 3 hrs of credit.

USA/MN Softball registration

All HFC players will be required to be registered with USA/MN Softball to participate in league and tournament play. If your daughter has played HFC in the last 2 years you likely have a player(family) profile and account. If not you will need to register for one. Once registered, the player's birth certificate will then need to be uploaded for compliance purposes. To register, login, and / or upload a birth certificate, please visit MN softball at lpsmn.com
