

Middle School Spring Registration

- Registration fee is \$600 and includes the following:
 - Coaches Player Pack
 - Raffle Tickets \$200 worth of raffle tickets, that can be resold to cover the cost of registration.
 - Each player will receive 20 tickets \$10 per ticket to sell to friends and family.
 - Families will keep all monies from selling the raffle ticket
 - Prizes:
 - 1st Prize \$1,200 cash
 - 2nd Prize \$600 cash
 - 3rd Prize \$600 cash
 - Raffle will be held at end of season banquet
 - Uniform \$150 deposit is required- check written to HHSLBC.
 Check will not be cashed unless uniform not returned.
- All boys must have a US Lacrosse membership valid through
 12/2023
- Teams are mostly determined by grade but also dependent on numbers in each grade. The 6/7 grade team will consist of 6th and 7th graders and the 8th grade team will be 8th graders and potentially some 7th graders.
- Spring practice days, times and games are being finalized and will be announced in the coming weeks. The boys will practice at night 2-3 days per week.
