

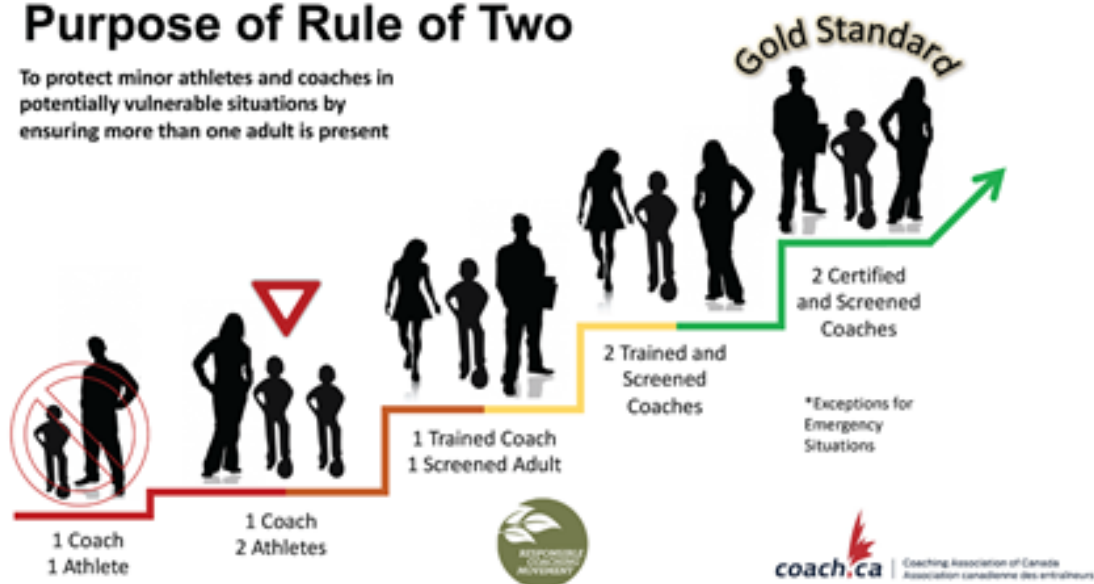
RULE OF TWO POLICY

When a KNSC Coach, Volunteer Coach, Assistant Coach or Manager is in a potentially vulnerable situation with any KNSC player (example - locker room or meeting room), another KNSC Coach, Volunteer Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager or the parent/guardian of the player(s) must be present.

In any one-on-one situation with any KNSC player, **there must** be a Coach, Assistant Coach or Manager of the same gender present, or the player's parent/guardian must be present.

Purpose of Rule of Two

To protect minor athletes and coaches in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring more than one adult is present



Gender Identity

A Person in Authority who is interacting with athletes should be of the same gender identity as the athletes. The following guidelines are strongly recommended:

- For teams consisting of athletes of just one gender identity, a Person in Authority of the same gender identity should be available to participate or attend every interaction
- For teams consisting of athletes of more than one gender identity (e.g., co-ed teams), a Person in Authority of each gender identity should be available to participate or attend every interaction
