➤ Based on Amanda Boberg's input on the number of DIBS positions/hours that are needed to run the MYHA; the MYHA/Marauders (Co-op) U10, U12 and U15 parents will continue to be required to complete eight (8) DIBS per registered player for the 2023-2024 season.

Treasurer (Krissy Wright)

Finance/Budget

- Krissy e-mailed out the budget earlier today:
 - o As of Sept. 17th; MYHA has \$388k cash in the bank
 - Traveling team registrations closed on 9/15/2023; there were 28 more traveling registrations than budgeted; \$56k more in registration dollars; anticipate this number will go down once HS tryouts are finalized; 14 more U15 registered than our final numbers last year.
 - Looking to Garth to provide an update at the meeting on expected move ups to HS on the girls side and confirm if there are more pending girls tournaments to pay for. Garth to f/up with Krissy.
 - Mite/U6/U8 levels; registration remain open; numbers are lightest on the U8 side compared to prior years; we are in good shape compared to budget on registrations.
 - MYHA will be required to obtain an audit for our books; Krissy to work with Jenny Garrity, Bookkeeper, and our accounting firm to get this scheduled; this is based on our income (primarily registrations) from the 22-23 season.

 - > Team Size Discussion; sixty-five (65) skaters; five (5) goalies.
