



Sport Stable Guidelines

Team Practices & Games

Things To Know:

- All Players will enter through the main Sport Stable entrance for each ice session with a mask on and remain socially distant during check-in.
- Players should not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to each of their ice sessions and should come partially dressed in order to minimize the amount of time spent in the locker room.
- Players will check in at the front desk of the Sport Stable and complete the following:
 - All participants will have their temperature taken each time they enter. Anyone with a reading higher than 100.4 will not be permitted and asked to leave the facility.
 - Anybody showing symptoms or has knowledge of exposure to COVID-19 within the last 14 days will not be permitted to participate.
 - Players will complete an emergency contact form if they don't already have an account set up in our system containing that information.
 - Players will be given a locker room assignment upon entering the rink. All players will need to stay in their locker room area until their ice session begins in order to make sure different groups of players don't come in contact with each other. Each locker room will have a maximum of 10 athletes with 6' of social distancing.
- All participants will be required to wear a ***face covering at all times, including athletes during play.***
- All players should bring their own water bottle. Please label the water bottle with the player's name and do not share your water bottle with a teammate.
- Locker room showers will not be available for use.
- Players need to change and depart the building immediately after their sessions. Players will exit from the West rink, west exit.
- Game pucks will be sanitized.
- Sanitation Material will be in prime locations for game personnel, team & coaching staff to clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and equipment.
- Each team will be limited to a maximum of twenty players plus their coaching staff.
- Unnecessary contact such as handshakes, fist bumps, hugging, etc. is not permitted.



What the Sport Stable is doing to help keep your players safe:

- The Sport Stable is adhering to the Colorado State Mask Order. Please always wear a mask while in the facility.

- COVID-19 symptom and temperature checks will be done for all players and coaches.
- We are utilizing both rinks and staggering start and stop times to reduce numbers in the building, increase time for thorough sanitizing, and utilize separate entrances and exits to minimize contact between different player groups.
- Using 12-16 designated locker rooms to allow for 6' social distancing for all players.
- Locker Rooms and common areas will be sanitized between usage.
- If you forget / do not have a mask, a new one will be provided to you by the Sport Stable front desk staff.
- At this time, the south entrance of the Sport Stable is closed. The south parking lot is open for overflow parking as players are asked to enter through the main entrance.
- First aid items can be found at the front desk.
- Entrance point: Main Sport Stable - Exit point: West rink, west door.

Parents, the Sport Stable is under a no spectator policy inside the facility per Boulder County Health guidelines due to COVID-19 restrictions placed on the number of people we can have in the building at any one time. Rock Creek Bar & Grill (West entrance, stairs up to the restaurant, ADA access through the main lobby to the elevator) will be open at 25% capacity for indoor dining and are following all state, county and CDC restaurant guidelines.
