Becoming a WIAA Official

Looking to make some extra cash? Become an official!

Wisconsin is in dire need of young officials - without new officials, our sport is in grave danger. If you interested in becoming involved, or simply looking for information, you can talk to Coach Gerber or follow the link above and see what becoming an official is all about. Additionally, high school wrestlers can get a limited official license at no cost through the WIAA. College students may get similar options. This is a great way to get involved. If you're not totally interested in doing varsity matches, get your feet wet by officiating at middle school and junior varsity events. Again, this is a great way to give back but also make some extra cash.

We can only wrestle if there is somebody there to officiate. The Wisconsin Wrestling Coaches Association was informed at its 2017-18 fall clinic that there WOULD NOT be enough officials to cover that year's WIAA Regional tournaments. Since, more officials have retired from active duty. If this doesn't sound bad enough, many officials are on the brink of, or past, their expected retirement dates. Travel to any number of middle school or JV events and you'll find officials that probably are past their time but are continuing to officiate to help the sport they love. We can't complain about the problem if we're not willing to step up and do something about it. If you truly love the sport, help us to fix this very troubling problem!

New Rules this Year!

- ★ A wrestler will be inbounds if two supporting points of either wrestler are inside or on the boundary line. This could be two supporting points of one wrestler or one supporting point of each wrestler that is inside or on the boundary line.
- The Nelson-Cradle is a new illegal hold/maneuver that is a combination made up of a Half-Nelson on one side with a locked cradle from around the neck with the far side knee. The back of the knee acts as the other arm (armpit) to complete the Full-Nelson pressure on the neck and throat.
- * Repeatedly dropping to one knee, as well as one hand, to break locked hands is considered unsportsmanlike conduct.
