## **Alumni Update**

Each newsletter we plan on updating our readers on the life of a former North Tartan athlete. This month's selection is Cayla McMorris. Cayla played high school ball at Park Center High School. Cayla's North Tartan career spanned five years playing in the most prestigious tournaments in the country. At the end of her North Tartan career ESPN had Cayla ranked as one of the top 100 players in the country. After being highly recruited by schools all over the country Cayla accepted a scholarship to play for the University of Wisconsin. While playing for the Badgers, Cayla scored 1,074 points which puts her 21st on the schools all-time scorer list. Twice she was named All-Big Ten Honorable Mention. Cayla graduated with a degree in Commication Arts with emphasis in telvelsion and production. After a distinguished playing career for University of Wisconsin, Cayla has taken her talents oversees to Turkey where she is playing professionally for Nesbie Aydin.
