Fundraising

How it Works:

- **Upon registration you are paying your required \$50 fundraising fee up front.**
- **You can recoup your funds by selling 5 calendars.**
- **You sell 5 calendars, keep the \$50 collected, and turn in only the calendars**
- **Your child can sell additional calendars for a chance to earn prizes.**



Calendar Fundraising Process

All players will pay for 5 calendar raffles as part of registration. Calendars are \$10 each

Players are encouraged to sell additional calendars and earn great prizes and basketball gear!

Calendars (including the 5 you paid for at registration) will be available in the coming weeks. Watch the website for details, contact your grade leads or any Hoops Club board member.

Calendars can be sold through the Thanksgiving holiday and will be collected the week of Nov. 29.
