

## Direction to meets

### Directions to Cardinal O'Hara High School

From St. Anastasia, proceed East on West Chester Pike towards Philadelphia. Turn right on Route 320 South. Follow Route 320 for about 3 miles. Cardinal O' Hara High School is on the left after the Lawrence Park shopping center and across from St. Peter and Paul's Cemetery. The track is behind the school, just follow the one way signs around back.

### Directions to Chichester High School:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From Route 3, take 252 South to Route 1 bypass (just past Rose Tree Park). Turn right on the Route 1 bypass (South). Go past the Granite Run Mall to Route 452. Turn left on Route 452 (South). Go about 3 miles to a 5 point intersection. Go straight through the traffic light for a little over a mile. About ½ mile after you cross under Route 322, turn right on Meetinghouse Road (it T's in from the right). Follow Meetinghouse Road until you come to Chichester Avenue. Turn right on Chichester Avenue and go about 1 mile. Chichester High School will be on the right.

### Directions to Franklin Field:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

Take Route 3 into Philadelphia. Turn right on Cobbs Creek Parkway (the elevated train starts at this light. Go to the next light (1 block) and turn left on Chestnut Street. Take Chestnut down to 37<sup>th</sup> street. There's a parking garage between 37<sup>th</sup> and 38<sup>th</sup> streets. The only way to get into it is to turn right on 37<sup>th</sup>, Street, right on Walnut Street, right on 38<sup>th</sup> Street, and right into the parking garage. When you come out of the parking garage, walk down Walnut Street towards Philadelphia and turn right on 34<sup>th</sup> Street. You will see the stadium in two blocks. We will be sitting in section SH.

### Directions to Garnet Valley High School:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From Route 3, take 252 South to Route 1 bypass (just past Rose Tree Park). Turn right on the Route 1 bypass (South). Go about 5 miles to Valley Brook Road (it's the first light after Wawa Dairy and the road sign is on the left side of the road). Turn left. Go about 1 mile to Smith Bridge Road (it T's in from the right just past St. Thomas the Apostle church). Turn right. Go about 3 miles to a stop sign. Go through the stop sign and turn left on the first road after passing under Route 322 (about ½ mile). Garnet Valley High School will be on the left. The track is behind the school.

### Directions to Interboro High School

From Broomall/Newtown Square

Take Route 3 West to the Blue Route (Rt. 476) South. Follow Rt. 476 to Exit 1 (MacDade Blvd). At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto MacDade Blvd. Follow MacDade Blvd until you get to South Ave (about 3 miles). Turn right on South Ave. and then a quick left on Hillcrest Ave. Follow the road around to the track.

### Direction to Ridley High School

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From Route 3, take Route 320 South to Baltimore Pike (Springfield Mall will be on the right). Continue through light, Sproul Road becomes Swarthmore Ave. AT the next light, 320 South turns right – you go

straight and continue on Swarthmore Ave. At the next light (in about 1.5 miles), turn right (Morton Ave). Ridley High School will be on the right in about 1 mile. The track is around the back of the school.

#### Directions to Penncrest High School

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From St. Anastasia, Take Route 3 West to Route 252. Take Route 252 South to the Route 1 by-pass (just past Rose Tree Park). Take the Route 1 bypass West towards the former Granite Run Mall. Exit at Route 352 North (before the Mall and just after the by-pass connects up with Baltimore Pike). Follow Route 352 behind the mall through the first traffic light. Turn right on Van Leer Ave., about ¼ mile past the light. Take Van Leer Ave. to the stop sign. Turn right. Penncrest High School will be on your right in about ¼ mile. The track is around the back of the school.

#### Directions to Springfield High School:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

Take Route 320 South to Route 420. Turn left onto Route 420. Continue to the second light and turn left on Rolling Road. (Richardson Middle School is on the right and the trolley tracks are just ahead. Springfield High School is at the end of Rolling Road. There is parking straight ahead and to the left in front of the High School.

#### Directions to Strath Haven High School

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From St. Anastasia, Take Route 3 West to Route 252. Take Route 252 South to Route 1 (Baltimore Pike). Continue South on Providence Rd. (Rt. 252) beginning at the intersection w/ Baltimore Pike (Republic Bank & Lukoil on the corners). Proceed through 2 traffic lights. Approximately ¼ mile past the 2<sup>nd</sup> light you will make a left turn on to the grounds of the Strath Haven Middle School. There is a parking lot on your immediate right. However, this lot will fill up quickly. The track is adjacent to the parking lot. There is some limited parking behind the Administration House which is to the left of the track.

#### Directions to Sun Valley High School:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

From Route 3, take 252 South to Route 1 bypass (just past Rose Tree Park). Turn right on the Route 1 bypass (South). Go past the Granite Run Mall to Route 452. Turn left on Route 452 (South). Go about 3 miles to a 5 point intersection. Turn left onto Concord Road (it's a soft left, not a hard left). Go about 1 mile and Sun Valley High School will be on the right. The track is behind the school.

### Directions to Upper Darby High School:

From Broomall/Newtown Square

Take Route 3 (West Chester Pike) East towards Philadelphia. Travel past the Blue Route (476), past Eagle Road and past Manoa Road. Route 3 will start downhill after Manoa road and Kohls will be on your right at the bottom of the hill. The next light after Kohls (at the top of the hill) is Lansdowne Ave. Turn right. Upper Darby high School is on the left in about a mile (after the light at State Road). The track is behind the school.

### Directions to Widner University

From 476 South.

Take the MacDade Blvd exit, go right at the exit onto MacDade Blvd. Stay straight through 3 lights. At the 3rd light, turn left onto Melrose Avenue. Take Melrose all the way down to 17th street. Turn left onto 17th, you will see signs for Schwartz Athletic Center. Follow the drive way ALL the way around to the "back" of the building. There is a parking lot in front of the building, in the back of the building there are 2 parking lots. If the grass field is open it will be on your right when you get to the back of the building. The track is past the building (building will be on your left)...I don't believe they will let you park by the track.

From 252 (you can go 2 ways)

1. Stay straight on 252. It will then turn into 320, cross over MacDade (also called 22nd street). Stay on 320 until you see 17th street, it will be right after a Giorgio's Pizza. Turn left onto 17th street. Stay on 17th street, there will be an elementary school on your left and a dorm on your right, cross over Melrose Avenue and follow the drive down to the Schwartz athletic center. Follow the drive way ALL the way around to the "back" of the building. There is a parking lot in front of the building, in the back of the building there are 2 parking lots. If the grass field is open it will be on your right when you get to the back of the building. The track is past the building (building will be on your left)...I don't believe they will let you park by the track.

2. Stay straight on 252 until it turns into 320. At the funeral home (it's on your right) there is a street that comes out on an angle. Turn left at the light (I can't remember the street name). Take that street to 19th and go left. Take 19th to Melrose and go right onto Melrose. Stay on Melrose and turn left onto 17th, you'll see the sign for Schwartz Athletic Center. Follow the drive way ALL the way around to the "back" of the building. There is a parking lot in front of the building, in the back of the building there are 2 parking lots. If the grass field is open it will be on your right when you get to the back of the building. The track is past the building (building will be on your left)...I don't believe they will let you park by the track.
