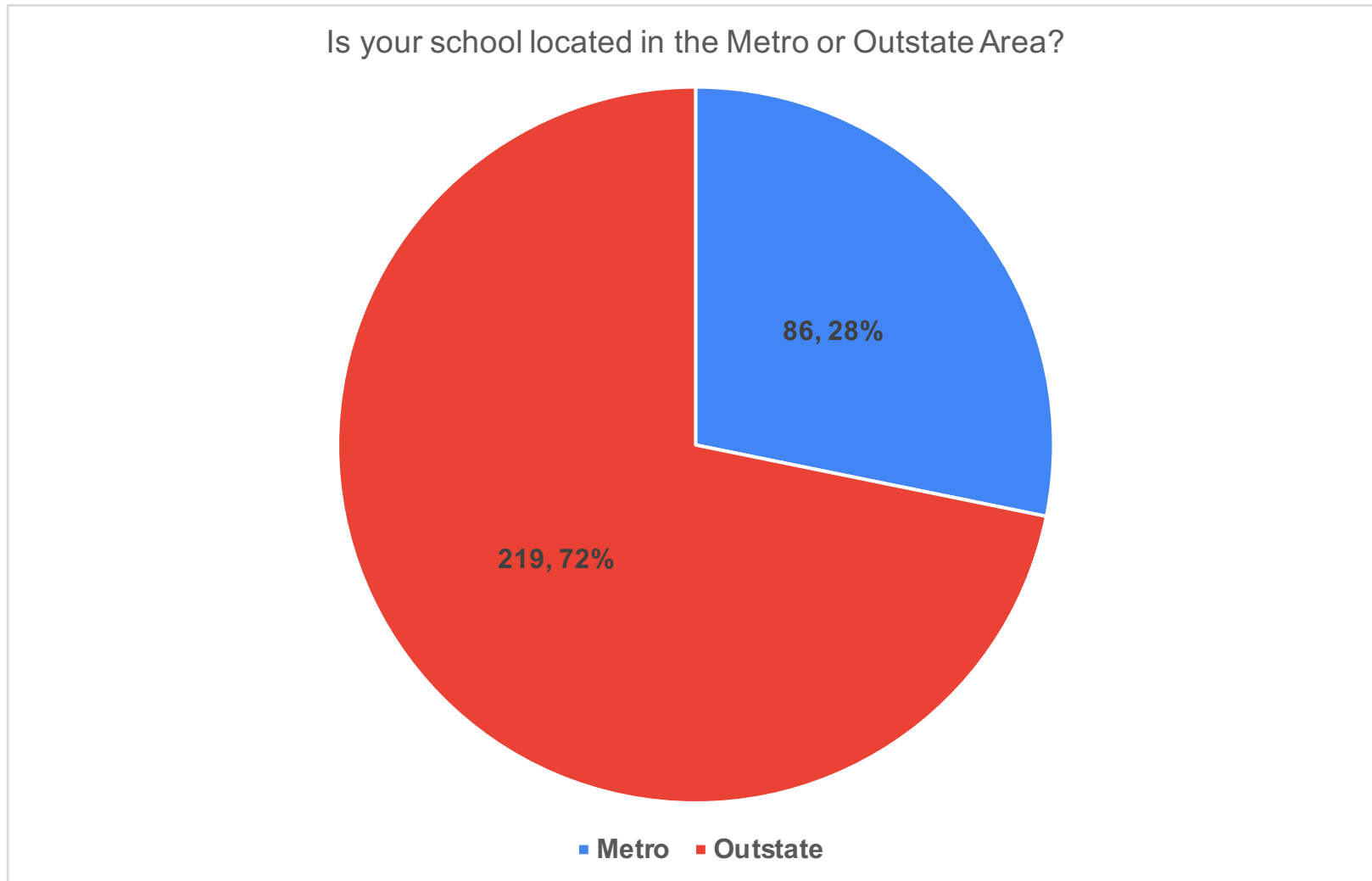


In which Class do you Coach?

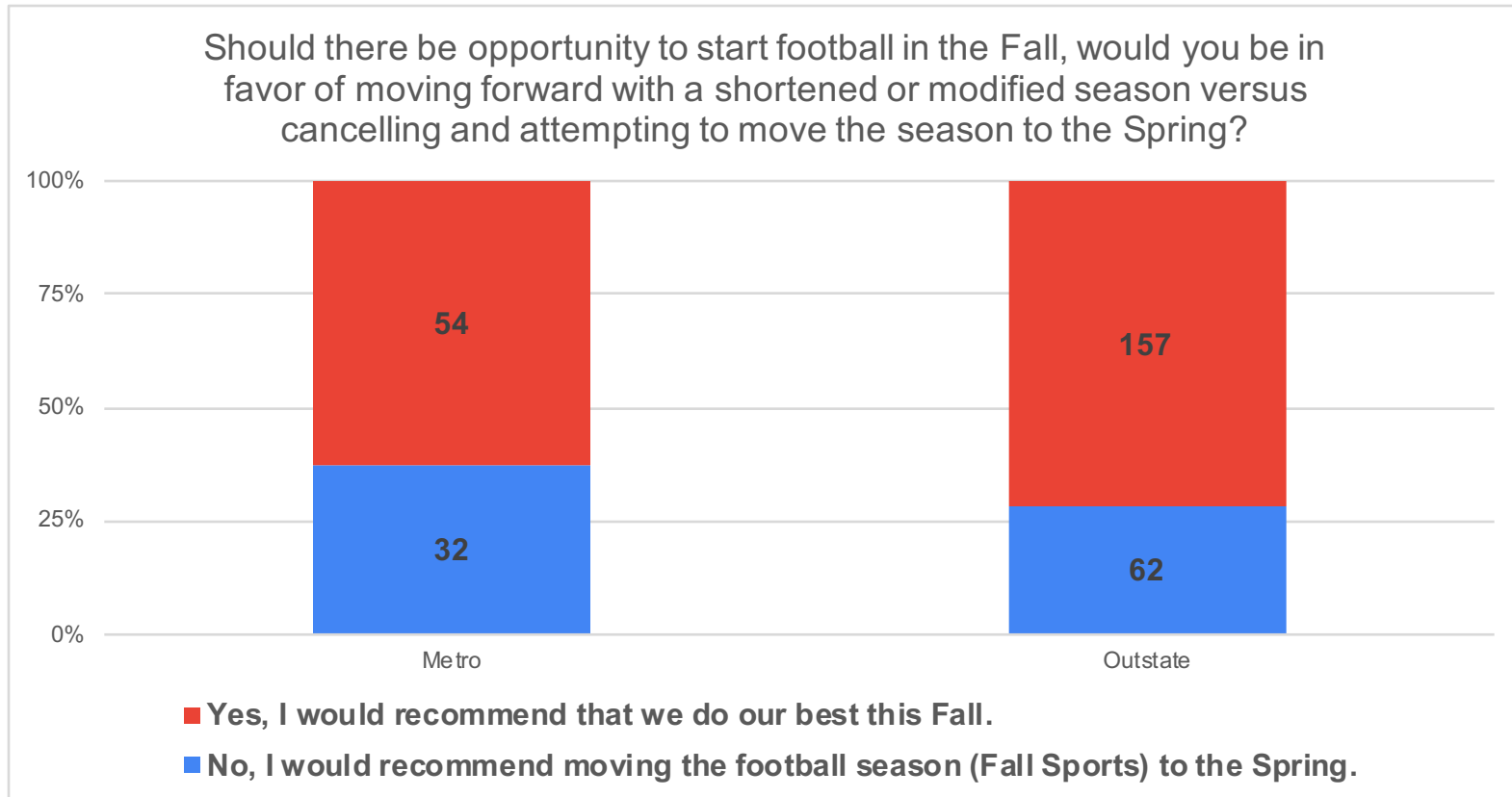
There are 305 responses coming from across all seven classes of football. There is a fair representation from each of the classes. No single class is significantly over- or under-represented by the responses.

 Responses to the following questions were divided to reflect the unique differences between these two groups regarding local Covid data.

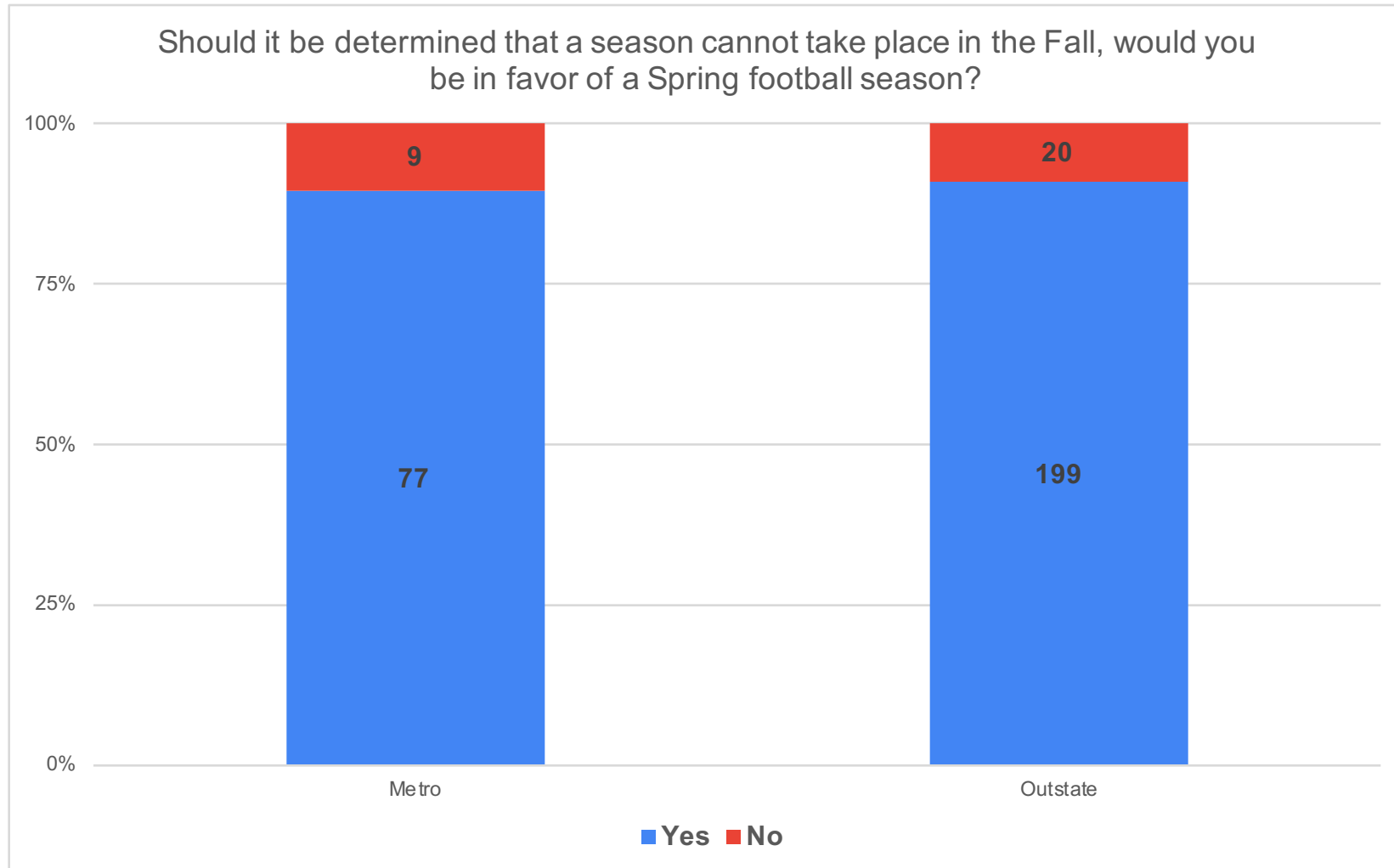


Should there be opportunity to start football in the Fall, would you be in favor of moving forward with a shortened or modified season versus cancelling and attempting to move the season to the Spring?

The responses were similarly in favor of playing this Fall for both the Metro (63%) and Outstate (72%) groups.

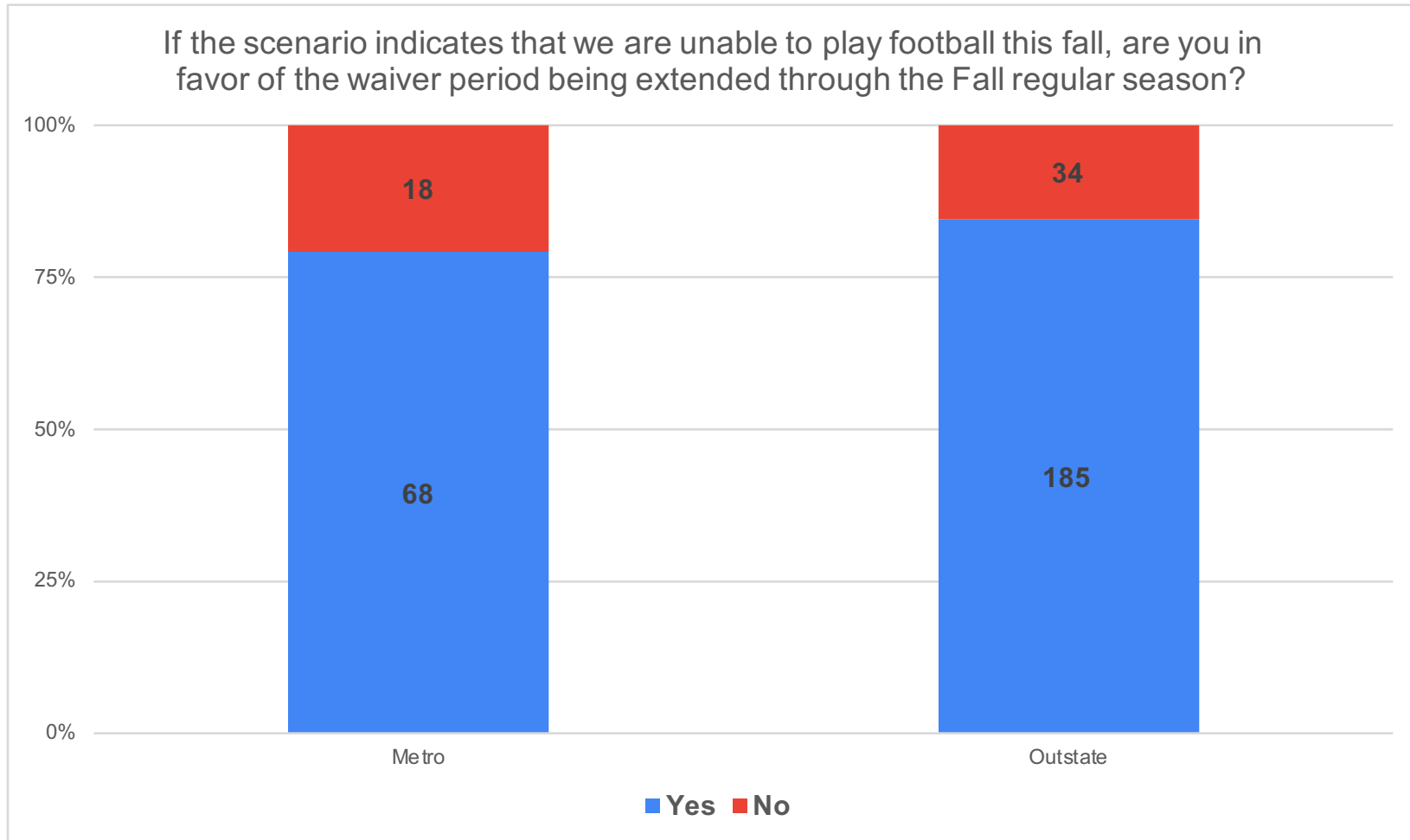

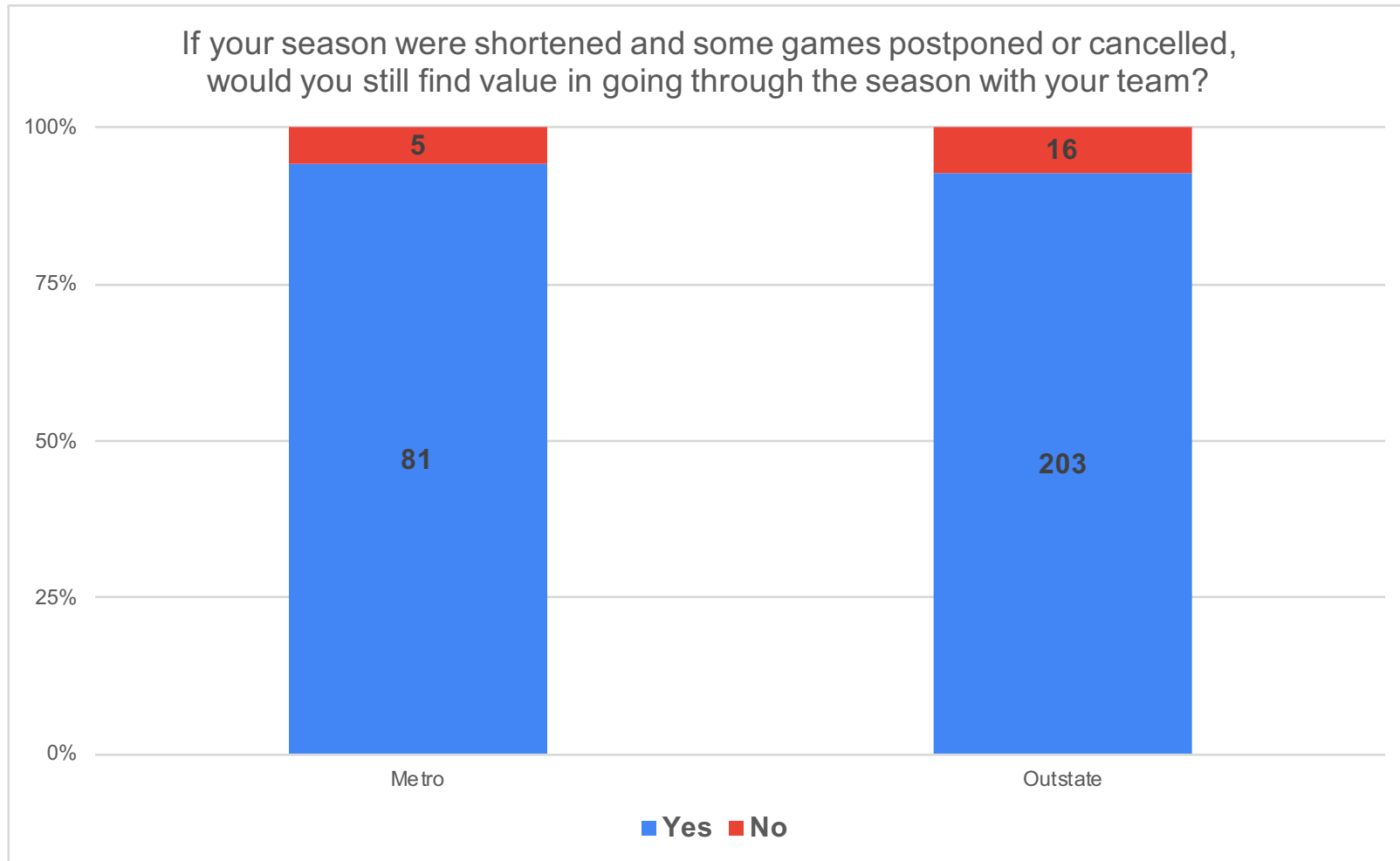
Both groups overwhelmingly agree that Spring Football is a good solution if Fall Football cannot be played. Metro (90%) and Outstate (91%) responded similarly.

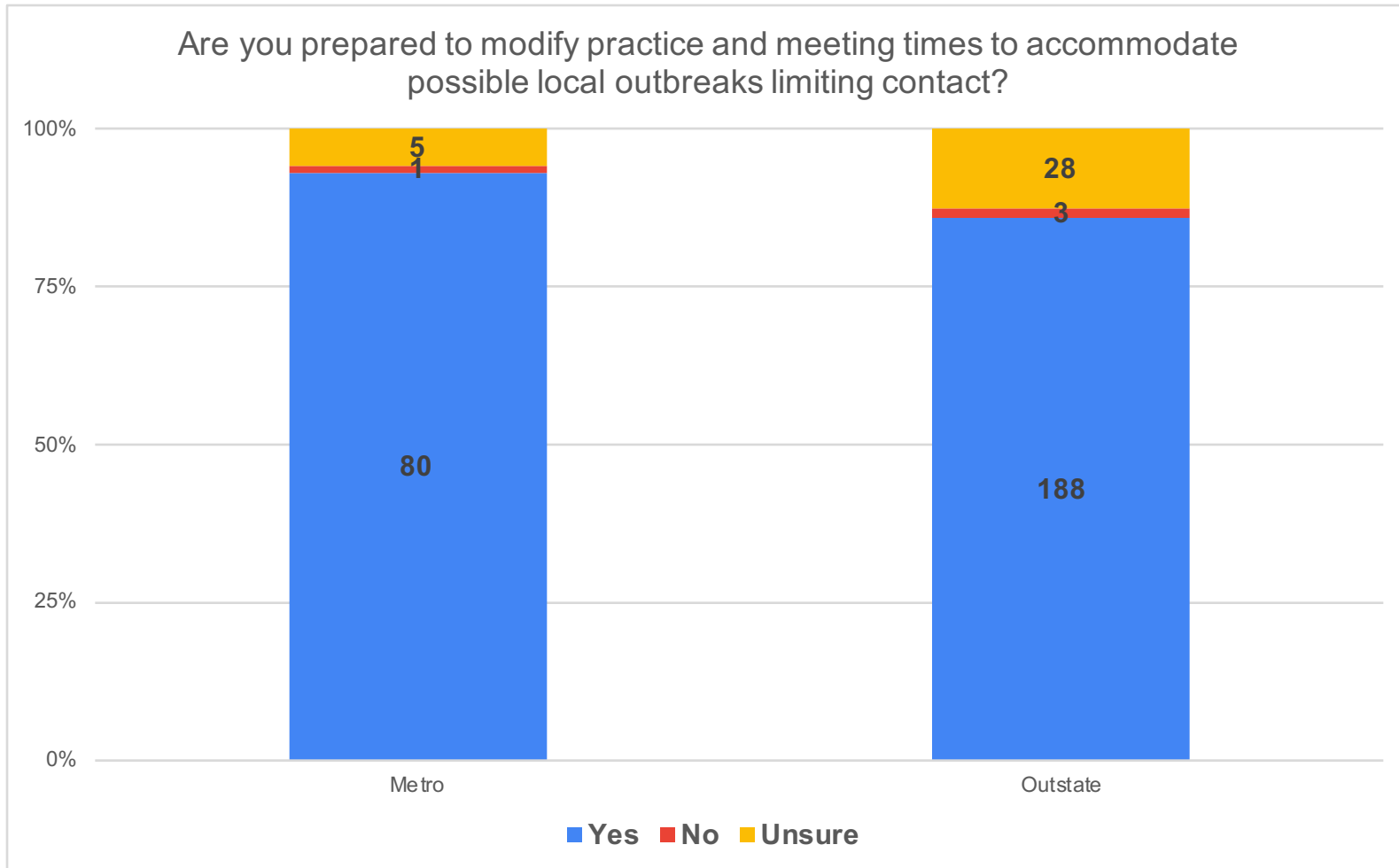

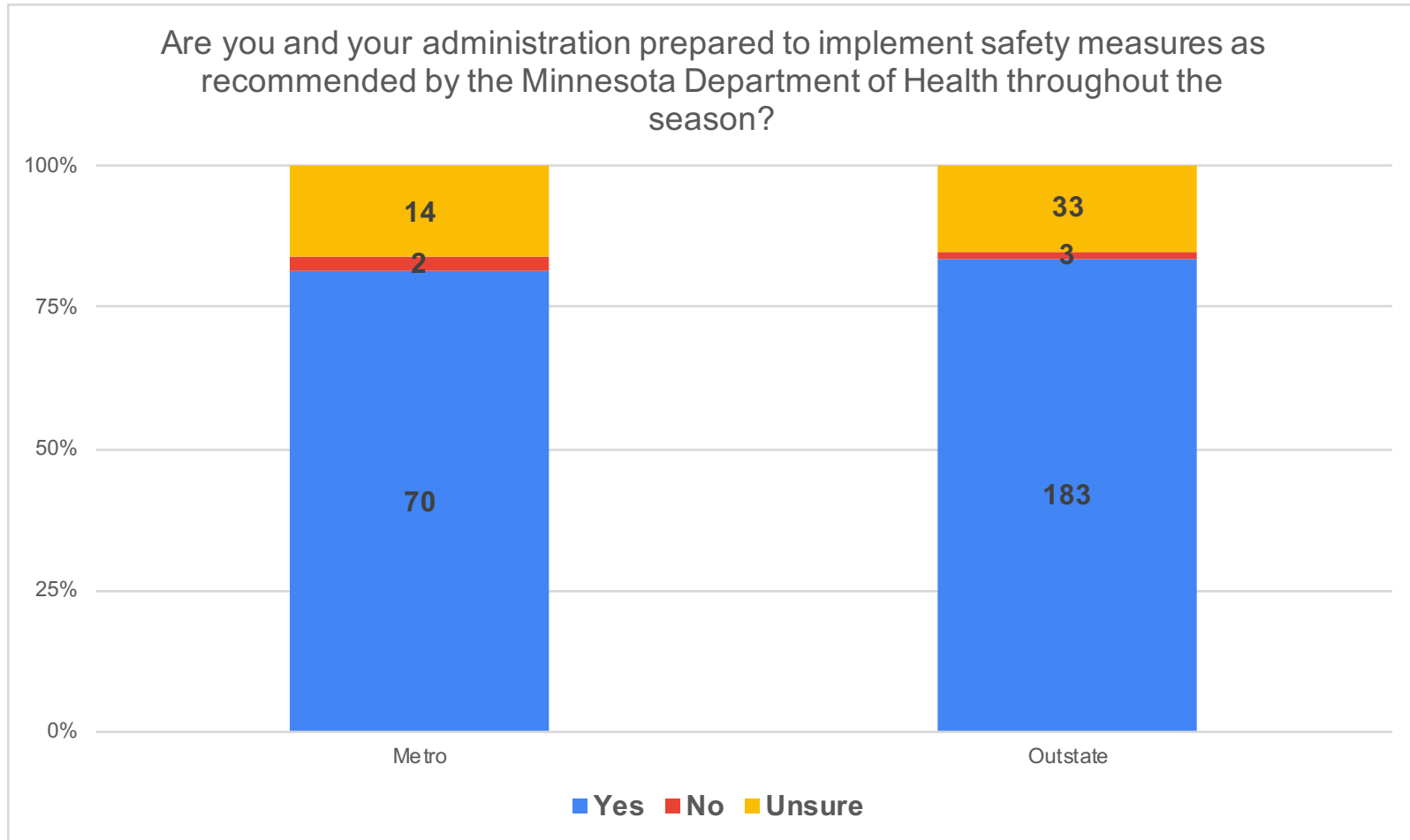

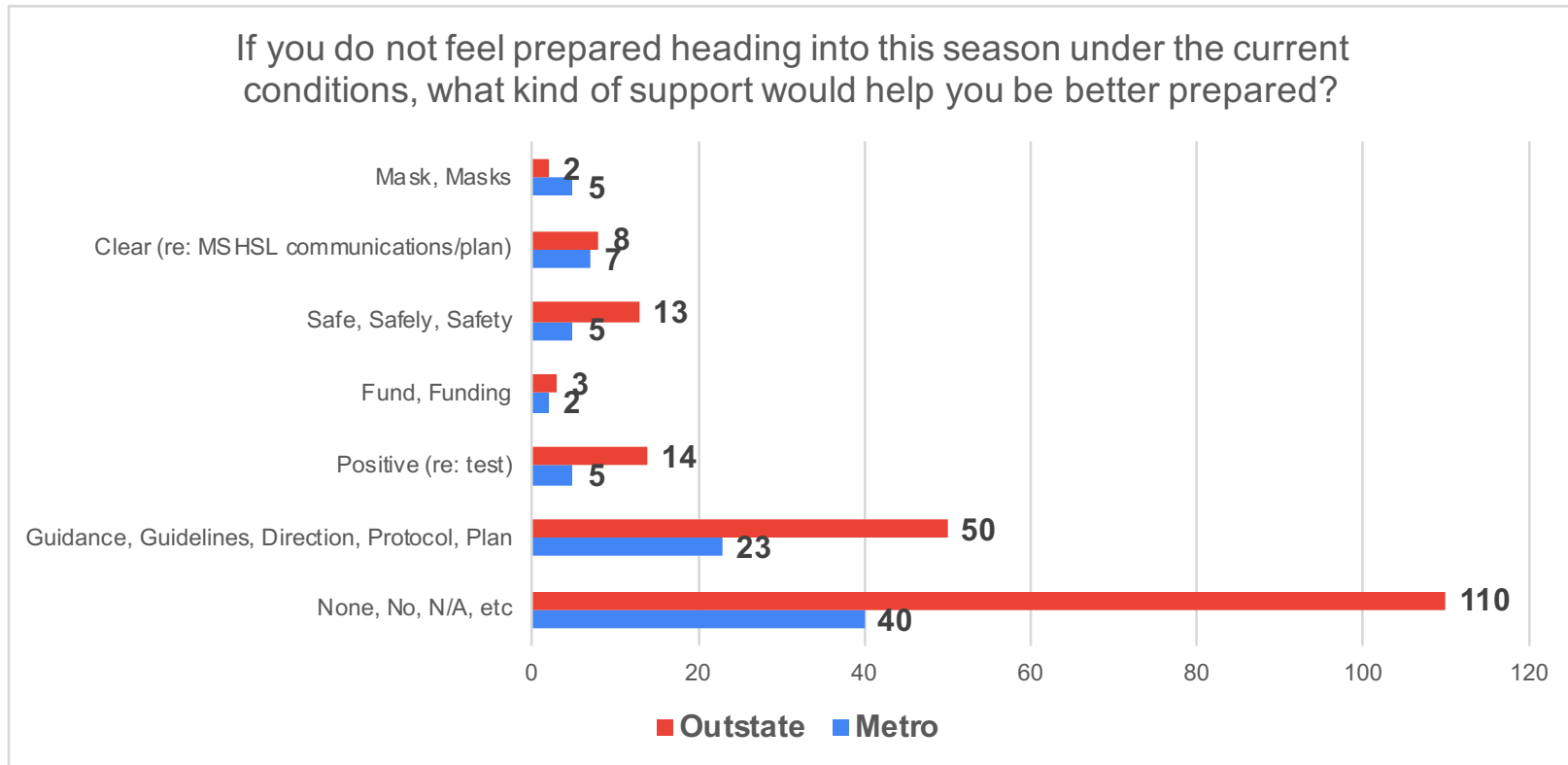

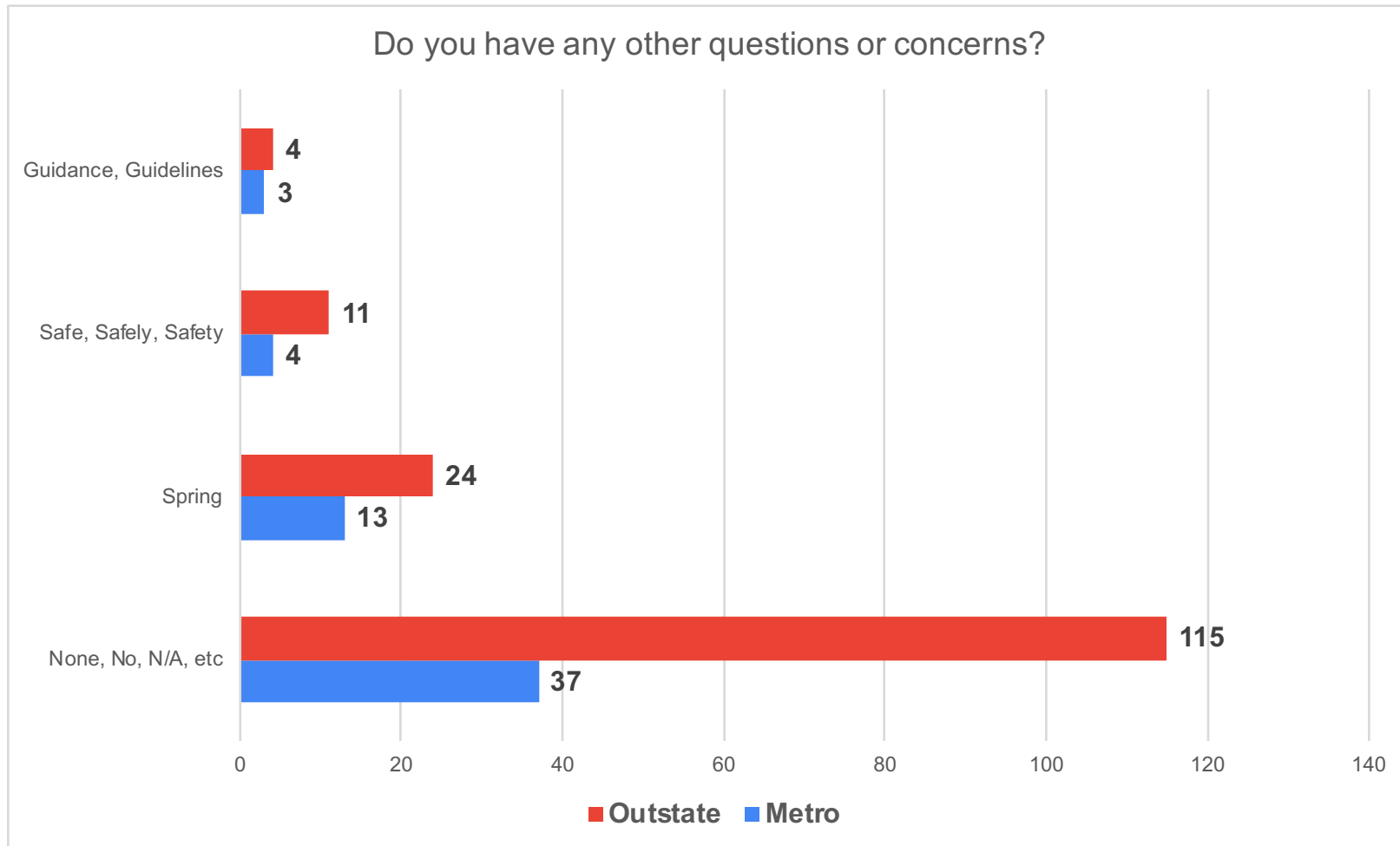
