Play-offs are held for Bantam, Pee Wee, Girls U15, and Girls U12 leagues. Participating teams are seeded into a double elimination Regional Qualifying Play-Off. Regional tournament entry awards for Bantam AA, Bantam A, Bantam B, Pee Wee AA, Pee Wee A, Pee Wee B, Girls U15B, Girls U12A, and Girls U12B district playoff teams will be identified in posted brackets once play-offs begin. Pee Wee B teams not participating in the Regional Qualifying tournaments are seeded into a double elimination District Tournament which will start on February 17th. Girls U15A tournament is being hosted by District 10.

Play-offs dates: February 17, 18, 19, 24, and 25 with Championship Day on February 26th Championship games will all be played at the Municipal Athletic Complex (MAC) in St. Cloud on Sunday February 26th. Come for a game, Stay for the day.
