

Eagle River Recreation Association (ERRA) - COVID 19 Policies
General Information:

**STAY HOME WHEN SICK OR IF DIRECTLY EXPOSED TO COVID-19.
DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR
OTHER ILLNESS.**

**DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH
ANYONE CONFIRMED WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE PAST 2 WEEKS.**

**DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE A 100.4 FEVER OR HIGHER
(EVEN IF YOU HAVE NO OTHER SYMPTOMS).**

PLEASE SELF MONITOR YOUR FAMILY FOR ILLNESS AND/OR SYMPTOMS.

Participation in any ERRA On-Ice or Off-ice activity by you or your child constitutes agreement of this document, the below risks, and the below rules. You (parent) and any participants must (1) comply with the COVID-19 policy, (2) Assume all risks of transmission and complications of COVID-19, and (3) Release and hold harmless the Eagle River Recreation Association and its home ice facilities from all liability and losses arising from your participation and your child's participation in activities organized, hosted, sponsored or participated in by ERRA. Furthermore, you understand no refunds will be issued due to quarantine requirements, or if a team has to cancel games due to not having enough players to participate for any reason.

All entrants into the rink will be required to wear masks at all times. This includes coaches, players, and any parents/spectators both on and off the ice.

1. Entrance and exit to both rinks will be clearly marked with separate doors for Entrance and Exit. Cube will be enter from the north and exit the south doors. Dome will be one way around the concession area and back out the second set of front doors facing the cube.
2. Skaters must bring their own water bottles.
3. Parents are required to keep players who are sick at home. Coaches will have the authority to send kids home if the child comes to the rink with symptoms of illness. Anyone with signs or symptoms of illness must not enter the facility. Parents must notify the Director of Hockey or Board President of any positive tests in a player's household.
4. **Players are encouraged to arrive at the rink dressed. They may enter the rink 15 minutes before practice time. Locker rooms have been assigned for U12 and above.** There will be a designating area seating for players U10 and below to put their skates on. This area will be located in the concession area and outside the entrances to both rinks on all sides.
5. **PARENT / SPECTATOR POLICIES FOR PRACTICE** – U10 and below participants shall come dressed but will be allowed one parent or other designated individual to enter the building with them and assist in tying skates, etc. Goalkeepers should do their best to follow this policy, but we realize they may need to put leg pads or chest pads on at the rink. U12 and up parents should be limited to one and practice strict social distancing policies.
6. **RESTROOMS** - Although the main lobby restrooms will be available, we ask that they only be used on an emergency basis.
