

## Park Strip Rules (10<sup>th</sup> & A)

**Starting Count:** An open count will be used, 0 strikes 0 balls. **Over the Fence:** Any ball hit over the fence will be an out with no further penalty. Any ball that touches a player and goes over the fence without hitting the ground will be a ground rule double.

Outfield Rule: Any ball rolling or bounding in the outfield will be a live ball, until the ball is obstructed in any matter (i.e. rolls under a bleacher, touches a spectator or player on or near another field, is picked up by a stray dog, rolls onto over a sidewalk, etc.) At that time the nearest fielder should raise both their hands and the umpire will call a dead ball if deemed obstructed. Runners will be awarded one base from where they were when the ball was obstructed.

**Bushes along 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue:** Any ball (batted ball or thrown ball) that touches the bushes along 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue shall immediately be declared a dead ball if the umpire deems it obstructed. On thrown balls, runners will advance to the next available base.

Only "Softie" softballs are allowed to be used on the Park strip.
