

FNL Coach Code of Conduct

As a youth sports coach, you are expected to prioritize the well-being of children, foster a positive and respectful environment, and uphold the highest standards of sportsmanship. Key elements include treating all individuals with respect, avoiding abusive language or behavior, and being a positive role model by demonstrating integrity, fair play, and proper conduct both on and off the field.

Friday Night Lights' coaches show respect for opponents, officials and fellow coaches. Coaches do not criticize or argue with officials or opposing teams. Always be gracious in victory and accept defeat with dignity. Encourage positive interactions and discourage negative behavior from players, parents and spectators.

Prohibited behaviors include the use of profanity or abusive language, being under the influence of alcohol or drugs during league events, and smoking or using tobacco on the field or during events.

Always place the athletes' needs and interests before your own. Any matter of concern can be addressed by a coach to the Commissioner, and an investigation will be conducted. At the conclusion of the investigation the results will be addressed with the coach.
