GAME TIMES:

TEAM ARRIVAL:

• Buses will drop off in front of Ames Arena & teams will enter through the Arena Main Doors.







LOCKER ROOMS:

- A Site Manager or an Assistant Coach will greet your team upon arrival and direct you to your assigned locker room. Locker room assignments can also be found on the monitors in the lobby.
- Teams may arrive 60 minutes prior to gametime.
- Team personnel, not arriving with the team after gates are open, MUST be on a Pass List

TEAM BENCH:

 The visiting team's bench will be the bench closest to your locker room (on the left when standing in the PA box, looking out onto the ice).

PRACTICE PUCKS/ GAME PUCKS:

• Lakeville North will provide both warm-up pucks and the game pucks.



SCOREBOOK:

• Lakeville North will keep a paper copy of the scorebook and provide the visiting team with a copy at the end of the contest.

PRE-GAME TIMING: Typical pregame timing for 5pm & 7pm game nights (adjust as needed for day games)

4:50pm JV 10-minute on ice warm-up (on clean ice)

5pm JV Game Starts (no ice resurfacing after warm up)

(JV games will take a 1-minute break between 1st & 2nd period & a full ice resurface after the 2nd period)

6:30pm Varsity 10-minute warm-up (on dirty ice)

if JV ends early, warm-up may NOT start before 6:30 if JV runs long, push back all timing as needed.

6:40pm Teams go off for resurfacing (15-minute clock will be set)
6:55pm Teams return to the ice for Introductions and Anthem

7pm Varsity Game Puck Drops

INTRODUCTIONS:

- Teams will line up on their respective goal lines at 6:55pm
- Highlighted youth skaters are introduced (presentation of the flag)
- Announcer introduces VISITING Team (players skate out to the blue line)
- Announcer introduces HOME Team (players skate out to the blue line)
- National Anthem is played
- Teams will them skate back to their net and then take their bench to begin the game.

TRAINER:

- Athletic Training services are provided by Summit Orthopedics.
- An Athletic Trainer will be onsite for all matches. Heather Bartz (MAT, LAT, ATC), Jessica Weideman (MS, LAT, ATC), or a casual assigned by the clinic.
- Players will bring their own water, ice will be available as necessary at the concession stand.
- A portable AED will be on-site with the Athletic Trainer.

TEAM VIDEO:

- Teams can record the game for from the top of the bleachers, behind their fan section (acrosse from Lakeville North's team bench)
- Livestreaming is NOT allowed without prior approval. Unauthorized team livestreams will be charged a \$200 game fee.
