Regardless of qualifications, a candidate cannot be selected for a head coach positions without completing an application form, passing the mandatory background check, completing AYF/AYC certifications, attending at least six (6) league meetings, signing the Code of Conduct, and approval by the League Board of Directors.

	Head Coaches are responsible for the behavior of all team coaches and volunteers. If at any time one of the team volunteers is ejected the Head Coach will also be suspended for a minimum of 1 game per BVAYF rules(Initials)		
	Head Coaches are responsible for their team's book during the season(Initials)		
	Head Coaches are responsible for handing in weekly practice attendance forms, MPR forms, game absentee and disciplinary forms to the football/cheer coordinator(Initials)		
	Head Coaches are required to volunteer for at least one home game not including one's own team(Initials)		
	Head Coaches are required to participate and support league fundraising events(Initials)		
	Head Coaches are required to provide at least three (3) game day volunteers (Initials)		
	Coaches may not sit out any participant without filling out and having the parent and coordinator sign the appropriate paperwork. All discipline will be discussed with the appropriate coordinator(Initials)

Assistant Coaching/ Team Mom Job Description

All applications should go to the appropriate Coordinator only.

Regardless of qualifications, a candidate cannot be selected for an assistant coach positions without completing an application form, passing the mandatory background check, completing AYF/AYC certifications, attending at least three (3) league meetings, signing the Code of Conduct, and approval by the Board of Directors.

Assistant Coaches and Team Moms are selected by the Head Coach and approved by the Board of Directors A Head Coach can remove an Assistant Coach from the team at any time with approval from the Board of Directors. (Initials)
Assistant Coaches and Team Moms represent their team, and their behavior can affect the outcome of the game, and future games. If at any time one of the assistant coaches or team volunteers is ejected the ejection period will be depending on the reason ejected, and the suspension time will be a minimum of one (1) game up to a full season (as voted on by a board of Presidents in BVAYF), and the Head Coach will also be suspended for a minimum of 1 game per BVAYF rules(Initials)
Assistant Coaches/ Team Mom must be 18 years old(Initials)
Assistant Coaches/Team Mom are required to volunteer during home games, each week, not including one's own team(Initials)
Assistant Coaches/Team Mom are required to participate and support league fundraising events(Initials)

2019 AYF Code of Conduct Form

This is American Youth Football, not the pros. Fans, as well as the players and coaches, are expected to abide by a code of conduct at all American Youth Football Events. While 99% of the adults in the program will abide by this code without being told, this code is being published to protect the children and volunteers (which include all coaches and board members) from the 1%.

Coaches will abide by a Code of Conduct which includes the provisions which follow. If any of these rules are broken, **JYFC** shall have the authority to remove and/or replace the coach.

Coaches shall:

- Not criticize the players/cheerleaders or coaches in front of the other spectators in the stands, but reserve
 constructive criticism for later, in private.
- Accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair and called to the best ability of said officials.
 Any complaints about field, officiating, or opposing teams should be made privately to the Coordinators.
- Not criticize an opposing team, its players, coaches, or fans by work of mouth or by gesture.
- Refrain from using physical or verbal abuse or profane language at any time at the game, practice field, or other AYF functions.
- Abstain from being under the influence of or in possession of and/or drinking alco- holic beverages and the
 possession or use of any illegal substance on both the game and practice fields.
- Not be allowed on the sidelines during any other teams game.
- Not interfere/interrupt other teams coaching staff before, during or after games or at practice.
- Not express complaints about other coaches or the Johnston Panthers organization in front of or around the children (i.e. right after a game or during practice).

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2019 Social Media Policy

The use of social media can be problematic when players, cheerleaders, coaches, or administrators use social media to berate, incite, insult, harass, etc. other players, cheerleaders, coaches, administrators, teams, or Associations by publishing, posting, or distributing inappropriate content including racially charged remarks. As individuals and as an organization, we need to have a zero tolerance policy for this behavior. As such, any player, cheerleader, coach, or administrator publishing, posting, distributing, etc. inappropriate content as described above on social media will be suspended for the remainder of the current season, including any post season play with no right for appeal. To ensure consistency in the implementation of the aforementioned suspension, three members of the Blackstone Valley Executive Board must agree that the offense meets the criteria outlined above.
