

The squad finished higher in 3 out of the 4 tournaments compared to last year, including a strong second place finish in regionals. All of this coming with a few starters out for major parts of the season. We showed great depth in making up for these losses. This year's Senior group did an outstanding job of competing and leading the way. It would have been fairly easy to throw in the towel after a disappointing loss to Vandalia, but things quickly turned around to finish the season strong. The squad should be proud of their 2nd place finish in a very strong Southwest Conference.

I encourage the Senior wrestlers and Zhanell (stat girl) to reflect back on what your years of wrestling has meant to you, and the life lessons you may have endured. Ciccarelli, Chris Flaugher, Morris Thomas) Waiting in the wings are some *very* talented J.V. and freshmen wrestlers who will be competing for full time Varsity positions next season. Competition in the room should be very strong. My advice to all returnees is to work for next year, *NOW*. Juniors – *one more chance*, Sophs – *don't wait until your Senior year*, Fresh – *catch up and improve your skills*. Being a championship team is all so possible next year, but only if next season starts *now*.

Thanks to everybody involved in Edwardsville Wrestling. The success we share is a total group effort between High School coaches, J.H. coaches, IKWF coaches, parents, Booster Club members, and wrestlers. I've always said our strong suit at EHS is working as a whole. Thanks for everything & good luck Seniors.

Junior Varsity Overview

The Junior Varsity Wrestling Team had a very impressive 2003-2004 season. The team finished second place in the Southwest Conference. Their only loss in conference play came to Granite City (43-50), in a dual meet that came down to the last match of the night. The team went on to lose just one more dual the rest of the season to a very tough Fort Zumwalt West team from Missouri. From there the team ran the table on Civic Memorial, Chatham Glenwood, Hazelwood East, Jerseyville, and Belleville Althoff to give them a record of 9-2 in dual meets for the season.

The team also competed in two team tournaments this season at Chatham Glenwood, and Lafayette high schools. We placed 3rd at the Lafayette Tourney, while being crowned Champions in Chatham.

The young men I had great fortune to work with this year made my first season at the high school level one to remember. As I sit in front of my computer and reflect on the season a smile comes to my face. Could it be the impressive dual meet record the team posted this season or winning 214 matches and loosing only 88 to opponents as a team?
