

Border Battle Rink Guidelines

Covid protocols for each rink are listed and linked below; it is imperative that these protocols are known to all players and parents and followed.

Somerset Arena: Masks are required for everyone over the age of 5, including players, parents, spectators, and coaches. A maximum of 4 spectators per player is allowed. There will be locker rooms available, but NO BAGS (except for goalie bags) are allowed in the rink, so players should enter the rink fully dressed. Full policy is found [HERE](#).

Hudson Arenas: Everyone who enters the buildings must wear a mask. Players should come to the rink as fully dressed as possible, to limit time spent in locker rooms. Full policy is found [HERE](#).

St. Croix Rec/Lily Lake Arenas: Masks are required for everyone who enters the building. Players should arrive fully dressed with the exception of helmets and skates, and bags are not allowed. Players can enter 10 minutes before game time, goalies 15 minutes prior. (Goalies can bring in bags and leg pads). Spectators are limited to two per player, and should enter the facility at game time. The full policy is found [HERE](#), under Youth Hockey Specific Policy.

HealthEast Sports Center (Woodbury)

Masks are required for everyone who enters the building. Players should arrive fully dressed and plan to not bring in bags. A maximum of two spectators per skater is allowed, including children. Full policy is found [HERE](#).

Spectator capacity is 200 per rink, so each team can have up to 100 spectators.

The purpose of this email is to remind all user groups of the COVID-19 protocols that are still in effect, specifically as it relates to the wearing of face masks. Executive Order 20-104 states that face masks are mandatory and must be worn at all times while indoors. At HealthEast Sports Center, this means that masks must be worn by athletes, coaches, trainers and any spectators when inside the facility and on the playing surfaces.

We were recently notified by the Attorney General's office that HSC received a complaint due to non-compliance with EO 20-104, players not wearing masks when on the playing surface. We take the safety of our user groups, spectators and staff seriously and want to do everything to maintain full compliance with not only the mask mandate, but all COVID-19 protocols.

HealthEast Sports Center staff will monitor the facility to make sure all teams, coaches and spectators are wearing masks. Should staff find there are individuals not in compliance, they will provide a verbal reminder to put on a mask. If individuals still refuse to comply, an announcement will be made through the PA system as an additional warning. Failure to comply with our COVID-19 guidelines and mask mandate may result in the event being cancelled. Should this situation escalate and the event is cancelled, no refund will be issued.
