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PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT 2022-2023

Parents are as critical to your player's positive lacrosse experience as any coach of the team.

Support Your Player.

- 1 Be supportive of your player by giving encouragement and showing an interest in his team. Let your player set his own goals. Be your child's "home field advantage" by giving him your unconditional support regardless of how well he performs

Attend Games.

- 2 Attend games whenever possible. If you cannot attend, ask about your player's experience

Be a Role Model.

- 3 Be a positive role model by displaying good sportsmanship at all times to coaches, officials and opponents. "Honoring the game" is a core value of Hoover Lacrosse

Let the Coach Coach.

- 4 Refrain from giving your player advice when he is playing. Also, let the coach know when he is doing a good job.

Respect Officials.

- 5 Respect the decisions of the officials. They are the authority on the field. Verbal abuse or harassment of an official is detrimental to the team, the league and the game – and will not be tolerated.

Read the rulebook.

- 6 The better you understand the game the more you will enjoy watching your son play

Get involved.

- 7 Keep score, run the clock, line the fields, raise funds, find sponsors, coordinate events, or volunteer in some other way

Represent.

- 8 Understand that as a parent of a Hoover Lacrosse player you are a representative not just of our team, but the school and community and must conduct yourself accordingly. Parents shall not engage in activities that reflect poorly on Hoover Lacrosse or Hoover High School.
