To All Predators Families,

As we make our way together through the latest government guidelines, please help keep our customers and youth and adult players safe by following the rules that we have implemented for all Predators events.

- If your child is not feeling well, do NOT bring him/her to the rink to skate with other players.
- If your family has been traveling to high risk states, you need to self-quarantine before bringing your child to the rink to play. See details below.*
- No handshaking, on or off the ice.
- Frequent handwashing.
- Bring your own water bottle and do not share with others.
- **Wear face masks inside the rink in all areas** except when skating on the ice.
- Players should come dressed in their equipment as much as possible to avoid crowding the dressing rooms.
- Because we need to limit the amount of people gathering inside the rink as much as possible, please follow these guidelines:
 - Only one spectator should come with young players if possible. All spectators should watch, preferably, from inside the rink in the bleachers at a six-foot distance with masks on. Any balcony viewing should also be at a safe distance. Remember that Live Barn is available for other family members to watch games from home.
 - The players on the ice should not exceed a total of 25 including coaches/referee.
 - Before and after games/practices, do not linger in the locker rooms or lobby to socialize. **Parents should wait for older players outside.**
- All snack bar food must be purchased “to go.”

* If you have traveled or plan to travel out of state, you will have to wait 14-days before returning to all Predators team related events.
