



Bingo Fundraising Policy

Dover Youth Hockey Association (DYHA) hosts bingo at the Dover Bingo Center in Dover, NH as our primary fundraiser. The funds derived from bingo are, in part, used to assist parents who work the fundraiser to defray the cost of hockey, league administrative needs, ice costs, training and other needs outlined by Dover Youth Hockey.

Members of DYHA over the age of 18 may volunteer their assistance to the Bingo Coordinator at Dover Youth Hockey Bingo to receive 'volunteer credits' to be applied to a registered players account. These credits equate to hours volunteered at Seacoast Bingo and are a reduction of current & future tuition fees only. Volunteer tuition credits are assigned on the day of service. They cannot be used to pay outstanding or past-due tuition, tryout fees, optional skill sessions/camps, equipment or jersey purchases or optional tournament entry fees. Volunteer credits have no cash or other refund value. Volunteering at Dover Bingo on behalf of DYHA does not release volunteers from tuition payment due dates and obligations unless agreed upon in writing with the league.

Commitment & Assignment

Bingo volunteers must be committed to the business of the Dover Youth Hockey Bingo, servicing the players and the job assigned to them by the Bingo Coordinator. Once assigned, volunteers will be placed on a team and all teams are on a year-round rotation. Additional shifts may be assigned based on business needs. Alternate commitments may be assigned with approval from the Bingo Coordinator & the Treasurer. Volunteering your time at Dover Youth Hockey Bingo is based, in part, by the number of volunteers required on specific days and as scheduled by the Bingo Coordinator. The number of volunteer hours required may vary from week to week. A waiting list may be employed, if necessary.

Assigned schedules/times must be worked unless a true emergency arises or other arrangements have been made with the Bingo Coordinator (at least 48 hours prior to assignments). Failing to show for scheduled dates may result in being removed from the fundraiser permanently. The Bingo Coordinator will have the right to assign or reassign volunteer responsibilities as might be required or deemed necessary to provide the best possible service to the business/players of Dover Youth Hockey Bingo.

Attrition

Volunteers whose dependents no longer play hockey for DYHA, either by leaving a team(s) or through natural attrition, will, as of the termination date or end of current season, relinquish their position to another family. If the volunteer/family has excess bingo volunteer credits, the family may donate them to a family of their choice or DYHA will reallocate these volunteer credits a general fund to support tuition assistance for families that have applied for a hardship. At no time may bingo volunteer credits be 'sold' or exchanged for cash or goods/services to other DYHA families. Any family found to be 'selling' or 'buying' bingo volunteer credits, will be removed from the bingo volunteer schedule.
