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# Overnight Trip— Student/Parent Form

The Girls' Basketball program at Seven Lakes High School has arranged an out of town, overnight trip to Bryan/College Station, December 26-29th, 2018. Student/Athletes attending this trip represent the Katy Independent School District and their school at all times. Student/Athlete participation in this trip or any other activity is conditioned upon the student's compliance with all applicable rules and policies before and during the activity. Any student who engages in inappropriate behavior while away from KISD on a school-sponsored trip is subject to immediate removal from the activity at the parent's expense in addition to any other school discipline which may be administered.

### Overnight Trip Rules for Student Participants

*"Athletes will adhere to the Board-approved Discipline Management Plan and Student Code of Conduct. No athlete may leave the team under the supervision of anyone other than his or her parent or guardian."* ~ Katy ISD Discipline Management Plan & Student Code of Conduct

In addition to the rules listed below, students are to abide by the Code of Conduct printed in the SLHS Student Handbook on pages 1-4 of the Student Activities: Travel section. Dishonorable behavior is regarded as a serious breach of school rules and grounds for immediate disciplinary action.

1. There will be no boys in girls' rooms or girls in boys' rooms for any reason except in the presence of the student/athletes coach or administrator.
2. Student/Athletes are not to be outside of their rooms after curfew unless accompanied by a coach or administrator. Student/Athletes will be given a coach or administrators number to call should they need to leave their room for any reason.
3. The possession or use of any tobacco or vapor products by a student/athlete while on school sponsored activities is prohibited.
4. The possession or use of drugs, chemicals, inhalants or any other intoxicants, or mood-changing, mind-altering drugs is prohibited. The transmittal, sale, or attempted sale of what is represented to be any of the above-listed substances is also prohibited.
5. Student/Athletes shall not be in the possession of any weapon as described in the Discipline Management Plan and Student Code of Conduct.

6. Student/Athletes shall not damage or vandalize property. Any damage will be paid for by the student(s) involved.
7. Student/Athletes shall not leave an assigned area for any reason. i.e., a restaurant where the team/organization is eating, contest site, or hotel, etc. Student/Athletes shall not get into vehicles other than the designated school transportation.
8. Any student/athlete in violation of local or state laws will be turned over to the local authorities. If the student/athlete is returned to the organization, he/she will be sent home.

**Procedures for Sending a Student/Athlete home before the end of a trip shall be as follows:**

1. The coach/administrator will notify the campus principal immediately upon being made aware of a violation of a rule. If the campus principal is unavailable, the coach/administrator will contact the Executive Director of Athletics.
2. The coach/administrator will call to obtain a schedule and cost for common carrier (bus, airplane, etc.)
3. The student/athlete will make a call home to the parent or guardian. Prior to the student/athlete conversing with his or her parents, the coach/administrator will inform the parents of the student/athletes offense, and that he or she will be sent home.
4. The parents will be asked on which common carrier they would prefer their child to be placed for the trip home.
5. Parents will be informed of the time schedule and the cost of the common carrier. Parents are responsible for the cost or they have the option of coming to pick up their child if they do not want their child sent home by a common carrier. Please note: Student/Athletes under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or school personnel if traveling home. Cost for both parties will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
6. The student will be separated immediately from the rest of the organization.
