Notes:

- It is our goal to be done with the tournaments no later than Friday, June 27. If rain causes cancellations early in the week, the schedule will be adjusted. All teams are guaranteed their first round game. Cancellations could result in some games being moved to Field 3.
- 10U No Pitching Limitations
- 7u coaches, during the tournament, the 37 ft arc will be lined on the field for infielders (3rd base, SS, 2nd Base, 1st Base, and Pitcher) to stay behind until the ball is in play. The outfielders (no more than four in the tournament) will start in the grass and can come in when the ball is in play. If you have more than 10, you can bat all and openly sub in the field.
- For the tournament, a team must have 8 players to start a game. Unless both teams are playing with 8, the team with 8 would take an out in the 9 hole in the batting order. You may call-up players from the age level below and put them at the bottom of the line-up and play them in the outfield. Only 10 can play in the field.
- All ties must be broken. If no winner is determined, in innings started during the time limit, subsequent innings will be played using the international tie break, until a winner is determined.
- Trophies will be given to the Tournament Champion for each league.
