#### 2019 SEASON OUTLOOK


The outlook this year for Panther baseball is filled with questions due to the graduation of eleven seniors from 2018's team. The losses are monumental, but potential replacements lend optimism for 2019 as top-end players do return to the middle infield from last year's 5th-place state finisher. Sr SS Gavin Baker (a .331 career hitter committed to D1 Indiana State University) has started 53 varsity games at shortstop and been voted All-State Tournament in 2017 and twice Honorable Mention All-South Suburban Conference. Baker will provide the backbone of the defense along with double-play partner Sr 2B Patrick Timmer (.295 in 26 varsity starts, .488 OBA, 20 runs in '18 & committed to NAIA Grand View University). The Panthers pitching staff will depend on Sr LHP Ryan Sleeper (3-2, 3.07 in two seasons, 73 strikeouts in 43 IP and committed to D1 University of North Carolina) to be its ace. Additional arms are lining up to help including Sr RHP Wes Kemming (committed to DIII College of St. Scholastica) and Sr RHP Devon Schewe (7 IP in 2018 and committed to JUCO Dakota County Tech). Other returning players with varsity experience include Sr OF Alex Tobias (30+inn played in CF) & Sr OF Brennan Kuebler. While Sr Josh Lee, Sr Mason Malecha or Jr AJ Anello will have the unenviable task of replacing 4-year starting catcher and 2018 Metro Player of the Year Nick Juaire. many more players will be required to successfully fill the remaining gaps if the Panthers are to return for a 7th straight Minnesota State Tournament.

#### THE SOUTH SUBURBAN CONFERENCE



In 2010-2011, 9 former Lake Conference teams joined Prior Lake to create the South Suburban Conference. It guickly became the state's most competitive baseball conference. In its first 8 years, the conference has had 5 of its 10 programs qualify for the large-school MN State Tournament, produced two state champions, placed 23 players on the All-State Tournament Team and 48 received All-State honors from the MSHSBCA. With alumni currently playing for NCAA-D1 programs including Illinois, Nebraska, Oklahoma State. Memphis, Missouri, TCU & Minnesota, four alums currently in professional baseball, and current players having committed to national programs including North Carolina, Oregon St & Illinois-Chicago, the Panthers and their partner schools are looking to cement their reputation as the best baseball conference in the state in 2019 with legitimate college & professional prospects competing in every game.


As a sophomore in 2017 plugging a hole at shortstop, all Gavin did was lead the team in batting average, provide stable defense, improve every day, and lead the Panthers to the MN State Tourney where he was named All-Tournament. As a junior, he played every inning at shortstop & hit well over .300 for a second year in a row- improving on his power numbers with 10 extra base hits & 18 RBI. As the Indiana State-commit heads into his 3rd year at SS, he'll attempt to bring LNHS its seventh straight Section Championship.

Grand View University (Iowa)

As a junior left-handed hitting second baseman in 2018, the coaching staff hoped Patrick could bring stability to the middle infield. The payoff was an everyday player that hit nearly .300 (18 for 61), added 20 walks to reach an OBA of .488, and scored 20 runs (good enough for 3d on the team). His glove proved more than adequate as he committed only one error in his first 20 games as a starter. In 2019, Patrick will climb into the top of the lineup and be counted on to provide experience and leadership in the infield.

This 6'4 senior lefty can climb the radar readings in impressive fashion. During winter training, his fastball reached 94 MPH. Add to all that velocity a swing-and-miss slider in the low 80s and you have the makings of a legitimate staff ace. In two varsity seasons, he has struck out 73 hitters in 43 innings pitched and allowed opponents to bat only .213 against him. Hardworking, dedicated, big and strong, Ryan will be the key piece on the mound to determine if he will appear in his 3<sup>rd</sup> straight state tournament in 2019.

# 2018 SEASON RECAP

Expectations were through the roof for the 2018 Lakeville North Panthers and Coach **Tony Market**, as the team was seeking a sixth consecutive trip to the Minnesota Large School State Tournament. Coach Market, whose 13 seasons as head coach at Lakeville North have yielded a 228-97 record and 6 state tournament appearances, was confident as his team returned the core of a dangerous pitching staff (with two NCAAD1 & two NCAADII commits) and the offense looked to be the most potent in years as Sr C **Nick Juaire** moved into his 4<sup>a</sup> year in the starting lineup.

The Panthers finished conference play with a 12-6 record, good enough for second place in the South Suburban Conference behind Prior Lake. The offense had clicked well in the regular season with Juaire and Sr OF **Zach Breeden** leading the way and staff ace Sr LHP **Nathaniel Peterson** was nearly unhittable winning three games, including striking out 20 in a victory against Apple Valley. But injuries took their toll as well, as the team was without two-year starter Sr P/OF **Nick Spitt** for most the season and lost Jr LHP **Ryan Sleeper** to a shoulder injury halfway through the conference schedule. Coming into the Section 1AAAA playoffs, with 15 consecutive section playoff victories (2014-2017), it didn't look like it was going to be quite as easy this time, but the Panthers went 4-0 in Sections and outscored their opponents 25-4. Peterson and Sr RHP/OF **Collin Denk** not only threw all 28 innings, giving up only 4 runs and 10 total hits, but the pair hit .565 with 13 hits of their own! Now the owners of a 19-0 record in their last 19 section playoff games, the Panthers were headed to the state tournament for the 6<sup>th</sup> consecutive year; the third longest streak ever at any level in Minnesota High School baseball history.

In game one of the state tourney, the Panthers faced #4-seeded St. Michael-Albertville. Peterson threw a 3-hit complete game and the Panthers had 8 hits in total, but as Lakeville North celebrated Jr SS Gavin Baker scoring the tying run in the 7th inning, the umpires signaled for interference on another runner and the game came to a heartbreaking stop down 3-2. The Panthers headed to the consolation bracket the next day and crushed conference-rival Eastview 10-0 behind Sr 3B Jacob Grimm's 3-4, 4 RBI performance and Denk's third consecutive complete-game shutout (for which he was named All-State Tournament). In the consolation championship, Baker and Sr OF Braden Walsh gave the team a big early lead and pitchers Spitt and Sleeper coasted to an 8-3 win over Wayzata.

The pitching staff set school records for strikeouts in a season (247) and the offense for team batting average (.364) and on-base average (.438). Nick Juaire was named All-Conference, All-State and Metro Player of the Year by both Twin Cities newspapers. After hitting .500 in '18, Juaire ended his 4-year career as the all-time school leader in hits & walks. Peterson joined Juaire on the All-Conference and All-State teams with Denk & Breeden rounding out All-Conference selections. Baker, Walsh and Jr 2B **Patrick Timmer** were named Honorable Mention. For the 6th consecutive year, Coach Market's squad brought hardware home from the State Tournament. In addition to all the on-the-field accolades, Nick Juaire and Collin Denk were both named to the All-State Academic Team and, for registering a team GPA over 3.3, our varsity student-athletes earned *All-State Silver* recognition for academics.
