- Current state of fields is not bad

- Compared what other local clubs have for fields (Boyertown and Quakertown) they have 5 full size fields each and we have one at Camelot and not in good shape
- Green Lane Park (GLP) wants additional information on what we are looking for
- Other locations to be explored
 - Looking for boards blessing to share package with GLP while they are working on their feasibility for next year
 - Reached out to Sweet Water about space next to their barn
 - Will continue to explore options at Finland
- Priority list
 - 1st – finalize what we will do for all
 - 2nd – Assigning people to explore the other options and go for them
- In discussions with Boyertown about U13 boys using their memorial turf fields for our home games
 - Cost – Free
 - Use for Voltage and Valor
