To offset the cost of adding essentially 7 hours of ice to the program, I would suggest offering the players on the waitlist a chance to come into the program for the last seven weeks at a discounted price. Currently the waitlist has about 10 players, plus 2 more players who have recently expressed interest. If only half of that list signed up the cost of the extra sheets would be covered.

 - a. -- Monthly Financial Summary: Our checking account balance as of 01-01-24 is \$194,871.35. Our balance on this date last year was \$149,813.73. Significant revenues since last meeting include \$19,117 in Christmas Tournament registration fees; \$4,480 in House/MDP/LTS registration fees; \$3,917 in travel registration fees; \$3,568 in other Christmas Tournament revenue (swag, raffle sales); and \$708 in uniform payments. Significant expenditures from the past month include \$30,875 in ice purchases; \$8,352 in league fees; \$3,164,60 in Christmas Tournament expenses; and \$3,120 for referees.
