Sean is in his 8th season coaching the UGHS Broncos, bringing a wealth of both playing and coaching experience. After coaching club teams (Sockers F.C. and Fichte Rams) in Illinois early in his career he came to Wisconsin in 1998 to attend Cardinal Stritch

University. After playing four-years at Cardinal Stritch University earning 1st Team All-CACC honors as a senior, he enjoyed a brief professional stint with the Rochester Rhino's in New York before returning to Wisconsin to pursue a mathematics teaching career. At UGHS, Sean has taken the boys program from a 1-20 record in 2012, to their first WIAA regional title in 2018 and a state-ranking as high as 5th (division 2). The UG girls won their first Southern Lakes Conference and WIAA regional titles in 2018 as well. Sean is married to Sara Jung, with 9-yr. old son Nathan and 6-yr. old daughter Lillian.

Coach Filz is a former UGHS alumni who joined the soccer coaching staff in the fall of 2015. In his first year as the JV boys coach he set a boys soccer record with 12 wins finishing 12-3-1 overall on the season (to date, the winningest JV soccer season in history). While attending UGHS,

Adam earned 2nd-Team All-Southern Lakes Conference honors and honorable mention All-Racine County while leading the team in scoring his senior year and he was also team captain. Adam recently graduated from UW-Parkside after studying Marketing and is a fitness enthusiast of all sorts. Adam competes in national Cross-Fit competitions, having won several in the past year including the Annual Graveyard Games at Kenosha Cross-fit.

Total Player Development

Commitment to excellence on and off the field is the emphasis of the Bronco Soccer Camp. Players will be divided into groups by age and ability with a low staff-to-camper ratio for concentrated teaching. There is a strong focus on individual skill development and first touch as well as introductory team tactics. Naturally though, "fun" will be the main ingredient throughout the trainings.

Specialized Goalkeeper Training

The goalkeeper is a key position and will be given specialized training with a well-rounded approach for the technical and psychological aspects of the position. Keepers will work on their hand-to-eye coordination, positioning, and footwork, as well as introductory diving.
