
Advanced Development Program ("ADP") soccer registration for the main soccer season, September to March for girls and boys born 2018 (U8) to 2008 (U18).

Our current spring teal-and-black kits can be saved and used as a training kit, or 3rd alternate jersey in the case of a colour clash.


Pickup dates will be announced before the Fall/Winter season starts.
