Research shows that Match Officials are at increased risk for mental health challenges. When surveyed, the number one reason for Match Officials not returning to the game is maltreatment. Match Official retention and recruitment numbers are historically low, and if they continue at current levels will threaten the viability of our game.

Step two in Ontario Soccer's multi-year #NoRefNoGame Match Official Anti-Bullying and Harassment program (via <u>Bulletin #12022-042</u>), is the release of our Match Officials Anti-Abuse Poster to our valued members.
