Minutes

Treasurer Transition

Sara and Dustin met at First Interstate and she was added to the account. Kurt says the bylaws indicate that all four of the executive committee members be listed at the bank as check signers. Board agrees that at some point other check signers should complete necessary documents at First Interstate Bank.

Draft Disciplinary Policy and Revised Codes of Conduct

Practice Schedule

Dustin re-worked the practice schedule to fit two hours for House League. It served as a starting point. Robert is going to play with it further based on feedback from board members including looking at adding another 4:20 High School practice and possibly adding a morning practice for Bantams. We are at the point where we need to make sure of morning ice because Monday through Thursday evenings is full until 10pm with HAYHA division practices.

Website

Registration

The board discussed the importance of having plenty of locker room monitors per division to make sure the locker room is always being monitored during games and practices.

During Community Day, families can come skate for free, learn about hockey and figure skating, rent equipment, play street hockey and more.
