

SHOWTIME VS AMW

GAME ONE

"LOOSE" SINGLES AND GOES TO THIRD ON A SHOMER DOUBLE AND LATER SCORES ON A JT GROUNDOUT AS SHOWTIME QUICKLY TAKES A 1-0 LEAD ON MORABIA IN THE TOP OF THE FIRST. DAVID SUTTON'S SECOND INNING HOMER GIVES SHOWTIME A 2-0 LEAD. AMW TIES THE SCORE WITH BACK TO BACK SINGLES BY MO B AND JASON GINDI AND AN RBI DOUBLE FROM JD ALONG WITH MORRIS SHAMAH'S SAC FLY. 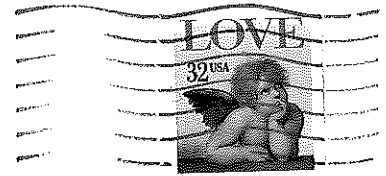
