

WEST SOUND YOUTH FOOTBALL LEAGUE PROOF OF SCHOOL ATTENDED

The WSYFL is focused on being filled with feeder programs for the local high schools. As such, a player will be eligible to play for a youth program if the school that they go to is zoned for the high school. Two forms of documentation will be required when registering a player.

Document One:

Utility bill showing address as proof of residency within the school district that the player attends school and is zoned for the high school.

- Gas
- Electric
- Water
- Sewer
- Phone
- Waste Disposal

Document Two:

Proof of school player attends. The document MUST show the name of the school the player attends, along with the players' name and the grade the player is in.

- Report Card
- Screenshot of school district parent portal
- Letter from school

If player is starting Kindergarten, homeschooled, or attends school in a school district that is not within the district zoned for the high school then you must provide a second document showing proof of residency.

Second proof of residency document:

- Driver's license
- Vehicle records (registration, lease, etc.)
- Employment records
- Insurance documents
- Welfare/childcare records
- Federal records (federal tax, social security, etc.)
- State records
- Local municipal records
- Support payment records
- Homeowner or tenant records
- Military records
- Voter's registration
